1. **REVIEW**

- A. DONNA AND I BELIEVE THAT THE <mark>BEST</mark> WAY TO "GET OBEDIENCE RIGHT'</mark> IS FOR <u>PARENTS</u> TO <u>TRAIN</u> THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u> IN <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>.
 - 1. WHAT DOES THAT MEAN...
 - a. IT MEANS THAT OBEDIENCE MUST BE TAUGHT !!!... PARENTS ARE <u>RARELY</u> SUCCESSFUL <u>TEACHING</u> CHILDREN <u>OBEDIENCE</u> WHEN WE <u>DEMAND</u> <u>OBEDIENCE</u> BY <u>THREATENING</u>, <u>BRIBING</u>, OR <u>NEGOTIATING</u> IN ORDER TO GET OUR <u>CHILDREN TO</u> <u>OBEY</u>.
 - 2. ANOTHER PRINCIPLE OF OBEDIENCE IS THAT CHILDREN WILL MOST OFTEN RISE TO THE LEVEL OF EXPECTATION OF THEIR PARENTS.
 - a. THE <u>PROBLEM</u> IS THAT <u>MANY PARENTS</u> <u>EXPECT LITTLE</u>... <u>AND</u> <u>RECEIVE EXACTLY</u> <u>THAT</u>!
 - b. DISCUSS:
 - 3. <u>Ephesians 6:1</u> (NASB) Children, <u>obey</u> your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <u>HONOR</u> YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise),
 - a. <u>NOTE</u>: IN THE EARLY YEARS, ONE OF THE WAYS CHILDREN DEMONSTRATE <u>HONOR</u> IS BY <u>OBEDIENCE</u>.
 - 4. <u>Colossians 3:20-21</u> (NASB) Children, be <u>obedient</u> to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord. (Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart.)
 - **a.** <u>**DISCUSS</u>: WHY... "<u>Fathers</u>**, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart"</u>
 - 1) <u>HOWEVER</u>... THIS WARNING CAN ALSO INCLUDE <u>MOTHERS</u>.

B. THREE COMMON WAYS <u>PARENTS</u> <u>UNDERMINE</u> <u>THEIR</u> <u>EFFORTS</u> OF BRINGING THEIR CHILDREN TO <u>GOD'S STANDARD</u> OF <u>OBEDIENCE</u>.

- 1. PARENTS OFTEN UNDERMINE THEIR EFFORTS OF BRINGING THEIR CHILDREN TO <u>GOD'S STANDARD</u> OF <u>OBEDIENCE</u> BY BEING A <u>THREATENING</u>/<u>REPEATING</u> <u>PARENT</u>
 - a. IF WE <u>TRAIN/TEACH</u> OUR CHILDREN <u>FIRST</u> <u>TIME</u> <u>OBEDIENCE</u>
 - 1) OUR <u>CHILDREN</u> <u>DETERMINE</u> <u>WHEN</u> <u>THEY</u> <u>WILL</u> <u>BE</u> <u>CORRECTED</u> OR RECEIVE <u>CONSEQUENCES</u> FOR FAILURE <u>BY</u> <u>THEIR</u> <u>DISOBEDIENCE</u>.
 - 2) DISCUSS
- 2. PARENTS OFTEN <u>UNDERMINE</u> <u>THEIR</u> <u>EFFORTS</u> OF BRINGING THEIR CHILDREN TO <u>GOD'S STANDARD</u> OF <u>OBEDIENCE</u> BY BEING A <u>BRIBING</u> <u>PARENT</u>
 - a. **<u>BRIBES</u>** INCLUDE:
 - 1) THREATS
 - 2) OFFERING REWARDS BEFORE BEHAVIOR
 - 3) SCARE TACTICS
 - 4) COUNTING
 - 5) REWARDS AHEAD OF OBEDIENCE
 - i. NOT <u>ALL</u> REWARDS, BUT REWARDS TO GET REQUIRED/ REQUESTED OBEDIENCE
 - b. <u>CHILDREN</u> OF BRIBING <u>PARENTS</u> OFTEN DEMONSTRATE THESE <u>SELF</u>-<u>ORIENTED</u> <u>BEHAVIOR</u> <u>PATTERNS</u>:
 - 1) SELFISHNESS
 - 2) PRIDE
 - 3) JUDGMENTAL AND CRITICAL TENDENCIES
 - 4) THEY BECOME MANIPULATIVE

- c. NO CHRISTIAN PARENT WOULD <u>TRAIN</u> <u>THEIR</u> <u>CHILDREN</u> IN THOSE BEHAVIOR PATTERNS <u>IF</u> THEY <u>UNDERSTOOD</u> <u>THE</u> <u>POTENTIAL</u> <u>OUTCOME</u> OF <u>BRIBING</u> <u>THEIR</u> <u>CHILDREN</u>!
- 3. PARENTS OFTEN UNDERMINE THEIR EFFORTS OF BRINGING THEIR CHILDREN TO <u>GOD'S STANDARD</u> OF <u>OBEDIENCE</u> BY <u>NEGOTIATING</u> WITH THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u> IN <u>CONFLICT SITUATIONS</u> = WHEN CHILDREN <u>DO</u> <u>NOT</u> <u>OBEY</u> THE <u>FIRST TIME</u> A REQUEST OR A COMMAND IS MADE.
 - a. THE <mark>ISSUE</mark> HERE IS A PARENT WHO IS CHARACTERIZED</mark> BY <u>NEGOTIATING</u> SOMETHING THAT IS <u>LESS</u> <u>THAN</u> <u>THE</u> <u>ORIGINAL</u> <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u>.
 - b. IN ORDER TO AVOID A CONFLICT, THE NEGOTIATING PARENT SEEKS TO COMPROMISE.
 - 1) THE PROBLEM: WHEN <u>CHILDREN BELIEVE</u> THAT THEIR PARENTS ARE <u>WILLING TO NEGOTIATE</u>... <u>NO INSTRUCTION SEEMS</u> <u>ABSOLUTE TO THEM</u>!
 - i. ... <u>RESULTING</u> IN <u>CHILDREN</u> WHO <u>RARELY</u> <u>OBEY</u> <u>THE</u> <u>FIRST</u> <u>TIME</u> THEIR PARENTS REQUEST.
- 2. <u>TWO PRINCIPLES</u> THAT HELP <u>PARENTS</u> <u>ESTABLISH</u> <u>THE</u> <u>CHARACTER</u> <u>OF</u> <u>OBEDIENCE</u> <u>IN</u> THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u>:
 - A. PRINCIPLE 1 IF/WHEN PARENTS <u>SPEAK</u> TO THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u> IN A WAY THAT <u>REQUIRES</u> AN <u>ANSWER</u> OR AN <u>ACTION</u>... THAT <u>PARENT</u> SHOULD <u>EXPECT</u> AN <u>IMMEDIATE</u> AND <u>COMPLETE</u> <u>RESPONSE</u>.
 - 1. <u>NOTE</u>: "<u>IMMEDIATE</u> AND <u>COMPLETE</u>" IS THE <u>GOAL</u>, <u>BUT</u> <u>MAY NOT BE</u> <u>THE REALITY WITHOUT EXCEPTIONS</u>.
 - a. THIS PRINCIPLE SPEAKS TO THE <u>PARENTS</u> <u>LEVEL</u> <u>OF</u> <u>EXPECTATION</u>... REMEMBERING THAT CHILDREN WILL MOST OFTEN <u>RISE</u> <u>TO</u> <u>WHATEVER LEVEL IS</u> <u>EXPECTED</u> AND <u>ENCOURAGED</u> AND <u>TAUGHT</u>.

b. NOTE: THE GOAL OF FIRST TIME OBEDIENCE IS OFTEN FAR LESS OF AN ADJUSTMENT FOR CHILDREN THAN IT IS FOR THEIR PARENTS!

1) DISCUSS: WHY MIGHT THAT BE SO?

- B. PRINCIPLE 2 NEVER GIVE A COMMAND (SPEAK TO YOUR CHILD IN A MANNER THAT REQUIRES AN ANSWER OR AN ACTION) UNLESS YOU INTEND FOR IT TO BE OBEYED ... UNLESS YOU WANT TO TRAIN YOUR CHILDREN NOT TO OBEY!
 - 1. "SAY WHAT YOU MEAN, AND MEAN WHAT YOU SAY".
 - 2. THERE IS NO BETTER WAY TO TEACH A CHILD <u>NOT</u> TO <u>OBEY</u> THAN TO <u>GIVE</u> THEM <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> THAT YOU DO <u>NOT INTEND</u> <u>TO ENFORCE</u>.
 - a. WISHING AND HOPING IS NOT A GAME PLAN FOR OBEDENCE!
 - 3. IF YOU WANT YOUR CHILD TO <u>OBEY</u>... DO <u>NOT</u> STATE YOUR <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> AS A <u>QUESTION</u> IN THE <u>FORM</u> OF A <u>CHOICE</u>.
 - 4. PARENTAL INSTRUCTIONS ARE EITHER:
 - a. **DIRECTIVE**
 - 1) <u>TELLING</u> YOUR CHILD WHAT <u>TO</u> DO, <u>OR</u>
 - b. <u>RESTRICTIVE</u>
 - 1) <u>TELLING</u> YOUR CHILD WHAT <u>NOT</u> TO DO
- 3. THREE WAYS TO MAXIMIZE THE SUCCESS OF YOUR INSTRUCTIONS:
 - A. <u>PROVIDE</u> A <mark>FIVE MINUTE</mark> WARNING
 - 1. <u>NOTE</u>: <u>SOMETIMES</u> (<u>NOT ALL</u> THE TIME) THE <u>TIMING</u> OF THE <u>PARENTAL</u> <u>INSTRUCTION</u> IS <u>AS IMPORTANT</u> AS THE <u>INSTRUCTION</u> ITSELF.
 - 2. <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> THAT <u>INTERRUPT</u> OR <u>TERMINATE</u> AN <u>ACTIVITY</u> SHOULD OFTEN BE <u>PRECEEDED</u> <u>BY</u> <u>A</u> <u>WARNING</u>.
 - a. PARENTS WHO <u>FAIL TO CONSIDER</u> THE <u>TIMING</u> <u>WILL</u> "<u>EXASPERATE</u>" THEIR CHILDREN.

- 3. THEREFORE, THERE <u>ARE</u> <u>SOME</u> <u>TIMES</u> WHEN IT IS <u>APPROPRIATE</u> FOR <u>PARENTS TO PROVIDE</u> WHAT WE ARE GOING TO CALL A "<u>FIVE</u> <u>MINUTE</u> <u>WARNING</u>".
 - a. "<mark>FIVE MINUTE</mark> WARNINGS" HELP CHILDREN TO EMOTIONALLY PREPARE TO COMPLY TO PARENTAL INSTRUCTION.
 - b. "FIVE MINUTE WARNINGS" (OR 8 MINUTES, OR 10 MINUTES) HELP REDUCE THE TENSION BETWEEN THE CHILD'S DESIRE TO CONTINUE WITH THEIR ACTIVITY AND THEIR NEED TO COMPLY WITH PARENTAL INSTRUCTION.
 - 1) **EXAMPLES**: WHEN YOUR CHILD IS...
 - 2) WATCHING A FAVORITE TELEVISION PROGRAM.
 - 3) PLAYING WITH FRIENDS.
 - 4) DOING SOMETHING ELSE YOU HAVE INSTRUCTED THEM TO DO.
 - 5) IN THE MIDDLE OF A PROJECT.
 - 6) ... DISCUSS OTHER EXAMPLES.
- 4. WHAT HAPPENS IF THE CHILD <u>CONTINUES</u> THEIR <u>ACTIVITY</u> <u>BEYOND</u> THE "<u>FIVE</u> <u>MINUTE</u> <u>WARNING</u>"?
 - a. <u>CONSEQUENCES</u>.
- 5. AVOIDING "EXASPERATING" OUR CHILDREN BY GIVING THEM "FIVE MINUTE WARNINGS" DOES NOT MEAN COMPROMISING THE STANDARD OF OBEDIENCE... BUT WORKING WISELY WITH IT.
- 6. DISSCUSSION: ON "FIVE MINUTE WARNINGS"
- B. PROVIDE A DOOR OF ESCAPE
 - 1. <u>PARENTS MUST TEACH</u> THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u> TO <u>LOOK</u> <u>TO</u> <u>THE</u> "<u>DOOR</u> <u>OF</u> <u>ESCAPE</u>" WHEN <u>CHALLENGED</u> TO <u>DO</u> <u>THE</u> <u>WRONG</u> <u>THING</u> (SIN).

- <u>1 Corinthians 10:13</u> (NASB) No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, <u>but</u> with the temptation will provide the <u>way of escape</u> also, so that you will be able to endure it.
- 3. GOD <u>NEVER ALLOWS</u> A <u>TEMPTION</u> <u>TO SIN</u> COMING FROM THE <u>3</u> <u>ENEMIES OF OUR SOUL</u> (THE <u>WORLD</u>, OUR <u>FLESH</u>, AND THE <u>DEVIL</u>/ <u>DEMONS</u>) <u>WITHOUT</u> <u>PROVIDING</u> A <u>DOOR</u> OF <u>ESCAPE</u>.
- 4. WHEN <u>PARENTS</u> ARE <u>TEMPTED</u> TO <u>SIN</u>... AN <u>APPEAL</u> <u>TO</u> <u>JESUS</u> (OUR <u>AUTHORITY</u> <u>FIGURE</u>) CAN BE OUR "<u>DOOR</u> <u>OF</u> <u>ESCAPE</u>:
 - a. "JESUS PLEASE HELP ME...!"
 - b. "IN JESUS' NAME I GIVE NO CONSENT TO THAT THOUGHT".
- 5. WHEN OUR CHILDREN ARE TEMPTED TO SIN... APPEALING TO A <u>PARENT</u> (THEIR AUTHORITY FIGURE) FOR <u>HELP</u>/<u>INTERVENTION</u> CAN BE THEIR "<u>DOOR OF ESCAPE</u>".
- 6. EXAMPLE:
 - a. TWO SIBLINGS <u>ARGUING</u> OVER A TOY.
 - 1) <u>BEFORE</u> USING <u>FORCE</u>, THE "<u>DOOR</u> <u>OF</u> <u>ESCAPE</u>" IS FOR THE <u>MORE</u> <u>MATURE</u> <u>CHILD</u> TO <u>TAKE</u> <u>THE</u> <u>CONFLICT</u> TO A <u>PARENT</u>... THE ONE WHO CAN <u>MAKE</u> <u>THINGS</u> <u>RIGHT</u>.
 - 2) NOTE: THIS BEHAVIOR MUST BE TAUGHT.
 - 3) TEACHING OUR CHILDREN TO LOOK TO THE "DOOR OF ESCAPE" BEFORE DOING THE WRONG THING IS GREAT TRAINING TO LOOK TO GOD AS THEIR "DOOR OF ESCAPE" LATER IN LIFE WHEN THEY ARE TEMPETED TO SIN.
- C. <u>REMEMBER</u> CONTEXT
 - 1. IN DEVELOPING OBEDIENCE IN <u>CHILDREN</u>, <u>PARENTS</u> MUST <u>GUARD</u> <u>AGAINST</u> CROSSING OVER INTO <u>LEGALISM</u>.

- 2. <u>LEGALISM</u> SEES ALL <u>DECISIONS</u> AS EITHER <u>BLACK</u> OR <u>WHITE</u>... <u>MORAL</u> OR <u>IMMORAL</u>... <u>RIGHT</u> OR <u>WRONG</u>.
 - a. <u>LEGALISM</u> DOESN'T ACKNOWLEDGE ANY <u>HEART</u> OR <u>MOTIVE</u> AREAS.
 - b. <u>LEGALISTS</u> TEND TO <u>DEMAND</u> THAT THE <u>CONSCIENCES</u> OF <u>EVERYONE</u> BE <u>IDENTICAL</u> TO <u>THEIRS</u>.
- D. YOU HAVE HEARD IT SAID, "KEEP THINGS IN CONTEXT".
- E. <u>CONTEXT</u> MEANS "THE <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u> THAT FORM THE <u>SETTING</u> FOR AN <u>EVENT</u>, <u>STATEMENT</u>, OR <u>IDEA</u> SO IT CAN BE <u>FULLY</u> <u>UNDERSTOOD</u>".
 - 1. CONTEXT GIVES US PERSPECTIVE.
 - 2. ONE OF THE MOST NOTABLE <u>CHARACTERISTICS</u> OF A <u>LEGALIST</u> IS THAT THEY <u>REJECT</u> <u>CONTEXT</u>.
 - 3. <u>PARENTS</u> WHO FAIL TO CONSIDER CONTEXT OFTEN EXASPERATE THEIR CHILDREN!
 - a. <u>Colossians 3:20-21</u> (NASB) Children, be <u>obedient</u> to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord. Fathers, <u>do</u> <u>not</u>
 <u>exasperate</u> <u>your</u> <u>children</u>, so that they will <u>not lose</u> <u>heart</u>.
- F. LEARNING TO LOOK INTO THE <u>CONTEXT</u> OF A <u>SITUATION</u> WILL <u>HELP</u> <u>PARENTS</u> <u>GUARD</u> <u>AGAINST</u> <u>LEGALISM</u> AND THE <u>ABUSE</u> OF <u>PARENTAL</u> <u>AUTHORITY</u>.
- G. CONTEXT ALLOWS OUR CHILDREN TO DO THE RIGHT THING BY TRAINING THEM TO THE PRINCIPLE... AND NOT THE RULE THE PRINCIPLE REPRESENTS.
