- 1. <u>REVIEW</u>
 - A. WE BELIEVE THAT THE BEST WAY TO "GET OBEDIENCE RIGHT' IS FOR PARENTS TO TRAIN THEIR CHILDREN TO OBEDIENCE.
 - 1. THAT MEANS THAT **OBEDIENCE MUST BE TAUGHT**!!!
 - 2. TEACHING TAKES:
 - a. <mark>TIME</mark>
 - b. **PATIENCE**
 - c. **DETRMINATION**
 - d. ENCOURAGEMENT
 - e. <mark>TEAMWORK</mark>.
 - 3. <u>NOTE</u>: PARENTS ARE <u>RARELY</u> <u>SUCCESSFUL</u> AT <u>TEACHING</u> CHILDREN <u>OBEDIENCE</u> WHEN THEY <u>DEMAND</u> <u>OBEDIENCE</u> BY:
 - a. THREATENING,
 - b. BRIBING
 - c. <u>NEGOTIATING</u>... IN ORDER TO GET OUR <u>CHILDREN TO</u> <u>OBEY</u>.
 - B. DISOBEDIENT BEHAVIOR IN CHILDREN IS NOT A MYSTERY!
 - 1. CHILDREN ARE <u>OFTEN</u> <u>LED</u> INTO <u>INSUBORDINATION</u> <u>BY</u> <u>PARENTS</u> WHOSE <u>INSTRUCTION</u> HAS <u>NO</u> <u>RESOLVE</u> <u>BEHIND</u> <u>IT</u>.
 - a. MANY TIMES THOSE CHILDREN WILL TAKE ADVANTAGE OF <u>PARENTAL UNCERTAINTY</u>, AND <u>ASSERT</u> THEIR <u>OWN WILL</u>.
- 2. THREE WAYS TO MAXIMIZE THE SUCCESS OF YOUR INSTRUCTIONS:
 - A. <u>PROVIDE</u> A <mark>FIVE</mark> MINUTE WARNING
 - 1. <u>NOTE: SOMETIMES (NOT ALL</u> THE TIME) THE <u>TIMING</u> OF THE <u>PARENTAL</u> <u>INSTRUCTION</u> IS <u>AS IMPORTANT</u> AS THE <u>INSTRUCTION</u> ITSELF.

- 2. <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> THAT <u>INTERRUPT</u> OR <u>TERMINATE</u> A CHILD'S <u>ACTIVITY</u> SHOULD BE <u>PRECEEDED BY A WARNING</u>.
 - a. AT THOSE TIMES PARENTS WHO FAIL TO CONSIDER THE TIMING WILL "EXASPERATE" THEIR CHILDREN.
 - 1) **EXASPERATION** IS THE **ENEMY** OF **OBEDIENCE**.
- 3. THEREFORE, THERE <u>ARE</u> <u>SOME</u> <u>TIMES</u> WHEN IT IS <u>APPROPRIATE</u> FOR <u>PARENTS</u> <u>TO</u> <u>PROVIDE</u> WHAT IS KNOWN AS A "<mark>FIVE MINUTE</mark> <u>WARNING</u>".
 - a. "FIVE MINUTE WARNINGS" HELP CHILDREN TO PREPARE EMOTIONALLY TO COMPLY TO PARENTAL INSTRUCTION WHEN THEY ARE PHYSICALLY, MENTALLY, OR EMOTIONALLY INVOLVED IN ANOTHER ACTIVITY.
 - b. "FIVE MINUTE WARNINGS" (OR <mark>8</mark> MINUTES, OR <u>10</u> MINUTES) HELP REDUCE THE TENSION BETWEEN THE CHILD'S DESIRE TO CONTINUE WITH THEIR ACTIVITY AND THEIR NEED TO COMPLY WITH PARENTAL INSTRUCTION.
 - 1) **EXAMPLES**: WHEN YOUR CHILD IS...
 - 2) WATCHING A FAVORITE TELEVISION PROGRAM.
 - 3) **PLAYING WITH FRIENDS.**
 - 4) DOING SOMETHING ELSE YOU HAVE INSTRUCTED THEM TO DO.
 - 5) IN THE MIDDLE OF A PROJECT.
 - 6) **READING A BOOK.**
 - 7) ... DISCUSS OTHER EXAMPLES.
- 4. WHAT HAPPENS IF THE CHILD <u>CONTINUES</u> THEIR <u>ACTIVITY</u> <u>BEYOND</u> THE "<u>FIVE MINUTE</u> <u>WARNING</u>"?
 - a. <u>CONSEQUENCES</u>!

- 5. <u>AVOIDING</u> "EXASPERATING" OUR CHILDREN BY GIVING THEM A "<mark>FIVE</mark> MINUTE WARNING" DOES NOT MEAN <u>COMPROMISING</u> THE <u>STANDARD</u> OF <u>OBEDIENCE</u>... <u>BUT</u> WORKING WISELY WITH IT.
- 6. DISSCUSSION: ON "FIVE MINUTE WARNINGS"
- B. PROVIDE A DOOR OF ESCAPE
 - <u>PARENTS</u> <u>MUST</u> <u>TEACH</u> THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u> TO <u>LOOK</u> <u>FOR</u> <u>THE</u> "<u>DOOR</u> <u>OF</u> <u>ESCAPE</u>" WHEN THEY ARE <u>CHALLENGED</u> TO <u>DO THE</u> <u>WRONG</u> <u>THING</u> (<u>SIN</u>).
 - <u>1 Corinthians 10:13</u> (NASB) No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, <u>but</u> with the temptation will provide the <u>way of escape</u> also, so that you will be able to endure it.
 - a. GOD <u>NEVER ALLOWS</u> A <u>TEMPTION</u> <u>TO</u> <u>SIN</u> COMING FROM THE <u>3</u> <u>ENEMIES OF OUR SOUL</u> (THE <u>WORLD</u>, OUR <u>FLESH</u>, AND THE <u>DEVIL</u>/ <u>DEMONS</u>) <u>WITHOUT</u> <u>PROVIDING</u> A "<u>DOOR</u> <u>OF</u> <u>ESCAPE</u>".
 - 3. WHEN <u>PARENTS</u> ARE <u>TEMPTED</u> TO <u>SIN</u>... AN <u>APPEAL</u> <u>TO JESUS</u> (OUR <u>AUTHORITY</u> <u>FIGURE</u>) CAN BE OUR "<u>DOOR OF ESCAPE</u>":
 - a. "JESUS PLEASE HELP ME...!"
 - b. "DEAR LORD PLEASE GIVE ME STRENGTH NOT TO ______.
 - c. "IN ESUS' NAME I GIVE NO CONSENT TO THAT THOUGHT".
 - 4. WHEN OUR CHILDREN ARE TEMPTED TO SIN... APPEALING TO A PARENT (THEIR AUTHORITY FIGURE) FOR HELP/INTERVENTION CAN BE THEIR "DOOR OF ESCAPE".
 - 5. EXAMPLE:
 - a. TWO SIBLINGS <u>ARGUING</u> OVER A TOY.
 - 1) <u>BEFORE</u> USING <u>FORCE</u>, THE "<u>DOOR</u> <u>OF</u> <u>ESCAPE</u>" IS FOR THE <u>MORE MATURE CHILD</u> TO <u>TAKE THE CONFLICT</u> TO A <u>PARENT</u>... THE ONE WHO CAN <u>MAKE THINGS RIGHT</u>.

- 2) NOTE: THIS BEHAVIOR MUST BE TAUGHT.
- 3) TEACHING OUR CHILDREN TO LOOK FOR THE "DOOR OF ESCAPE" BEFORE DOING THE WRONG THING IS GREAT TRAINING TO LOOK TO JESUS AS THEIR "DOOR OF ESCAPE" LATER IN LIFE WHEN THEY ARE TEMPETED TO SIN.
- C. <u>REMEMBER</u> CONTEXT
 - 1. IN TEACHING <u>OBEDIENCE</u> TO <u>CHILDREN</u>, <u>PARENTS</u> MUST <u>GUARD</u> <u>AGAINST</u> CROSSING OVER INTO <u>LEGALISM</u>.
 - LEGALISM SEES ALL <u>DECISIONS</u> AS EITHER <u>BLACK</u> OR <u>WHITE</u>... <u>MORAL</u> OR <u>IMMORAL</u>... <u>RIGHT</u> OR <u>WRONG</u>.
 - a. <u>LEGALISM</u> DOESN'T ACKNOWLEDGE <u>HEART</u> OR <u>MOTIVE</u> AREAS.
 - b. <u>LEGALISTS</u> TEND TO <u>DEMAND</u> THAT THE <u>CONSCIENCES</u> OF <u>EVERYONE</u> BE <u>IDENTICAL</u> TO <u>THEIRS</u>.
- D. YOU HAVE HEARD IT SAID, "KEEP THINGS IN CONTEXT".
- E. <u>CONTEXT</u> MEANS "THE <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u> THAT FORM THE <u>SETTING</u> FOR AN <u>EVENT</u>, <u>STATEMENT</u>, OR <u>IDEA</u> SO IT CAN BE <u>FULLY</u> <u>UNDERSTOOD</u>".
 - 1. CONTEXT GIVES PERSPECTIVE.
 - 2. ONE OF THE MOST NOTABLE CHARACTERISTICS OF A LEGALIST IS THAT THEY REJECT CONTEXT BECAUSE IT DOESN'T MATTER TO THEM.
 - 3. <u>PARENTS</u> WHO FAIL TO <u>CONSIDER</u> <u>CONTEXT</u> OFTEN <u>EXASPERATE</u> THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u>!
 - a. <u>Colossians 3:20-21</u> (NASB) Children, be <u>obedient</u> to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord. Fathers, <u>do not</u>
 <u>exasperate</u> your children, so that they will <u>not lose heart</u>.
- F. LEARNING TO LOOK INTO THE <u>CONTEXT</u> OF A <u>SITUATION</u> WILL <u>HELP</u> <u>PARENTS</u> <u>GUARD</u> <u>AGAINST</u> <u>LEGALISM</u> AND THE <u>ABUSE</u> OF <u>PARENTAL</u> <u>AUTHORITY</u>.

- G. <u>CONTEXT</u> ALLOWS OUR <u>CHILDREN</u> TO <u>DO</u> THE <u>RIGHT</u> <u>THING</u> BY <u>TRAINING</u> <u>THEM</u> <u>TO</u> <u>THE</u> <u>PRINCIPLE</u>... AND <u>NOT</u> THE <u>RULE</u> THE <u>PRINCIPLE</u> <u>REPRESENTS</u>.
- 3. <u>PRINCIPLES</u> THAT HELP <u>PARENTS</u> <u>ESTABLISH</u> <u>THE</u> <u>CHARACTER</u> <u>OF</u> <u>OBEDIENCE</u> <u>IN</u> THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u>:
 - A. PRINCIPLE 1 WHEN PARENTS <u>SPEAK</u> TO THEIR <u>CHILDREN</u> IN A WAY THAT <u>REQUIRES</u> AN <u>ANSWER</u> OR AN <u>ACTION</u>... THAT <u>PARENT</u> SHOULD <u>EXPECT</u> AN <u>IMMEDIATE</u> AND <u>COMPLETE</u> <u>RESPONSE</u>.
 - 1. <u>NOTE</u>: "<u>IMMEDIATE</u> AND <u>COMPLETE</u>" IS THE <u>GOAL</u>... <u>BUT</u> <u>MAY</u> <u>NOT BE</u> <u>THE <u>REALITY</u> <u>WITHOUT</u> <u>EXCEPTIONS</u>.</u>
 - a. THIS PRINCIPLE SPEAKS TO THE <u>PARENTS</u> <u>LEVEL</u> OF <u>EXPECTATION</u>... REMEMBERING THAT CHILDREN WILL MOST OFTEN <u>RISE TO THE</u> <u>LEVEL</u> THAT <u>IS</u> <u>EXPECTED</u>... AND <u>ENCOURAGED</u>... AND <u>TAUGHT</u>.
 - b. NOTE: THE GOAL OF FIRST TIME OBEDIENCE IS OFTEN LESS OF AN ADJUSTMENT FOR CHILDREN THAN IT IS FOR THEIR PARENTS!
 - 1) DISCUSS: WHY THAT MIGHT THAT BE SO.
 - B. PRINCIPLE 2 NEVER SPEAK TO YOUR CHILD IN A MANNER THAT REQUIRES AN ANSWER OR AN ACTION..... UNLESS YOU INTEND AND EXPECT TO BE OBEYED.
 - 1. PARENTS <u>LACK</u> OF <u>EXPECTATION</u> A GOOD WAY TO <u>TRAIN</u> <u>THEIR</u> <u>CHILDREN</u> <u>NOT</u> TO <u>OBEY</u>!
 - 2. THERE IS NO BETTER WAY TO TEACH A CHILD <u>NOT</u> TO <u>OBEY</u> THAN TO <u>GIVE</u> THEM <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> THAT YOU DO <u>NOT INTEND</u> <u>TO ENFORCE</u>.
 - a. WISHING AND HOPING IS NOT A SUCCESSFUL GAME PLAN FOR ANYTHING... ESPECIALLY OBEDENCE!
 - 3. "SAY WHAT YOU MEAN, AND MEAN WHAT YOU SAY".

- 4. AS A GENERAL RULE, IF YOU WANT YOUR CHILD TO <u>OBEY</u>... DO <u>NOT</u> BE <u>CHARACTERIZED</u> BY STATING YOUR <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> IN THE <u>FORM</u> OF A <u>CHOICE</u>.
 - a. "DO YOU WANT TO DO A, OR DO YOU WANT TO DO B?"
 - b. **<u>DISCUSSS</u>**: SOME <u>EXCEPTIONS</u>
- 5. <u>PARENTAL</u> INSTRUCTIONS SHOULD BE EITHER:
 - a. **<u>DIRECTIVE</u>**
 - 1) TELLING YOUR CHILD WHAT TO DO, OR
 - b. **<u>RESTRICTIVE</u>**
 - 1) <u>TELLING</u> YOUR CHILD WHAT <u>NOT</u> TO DO
- C. <u>PRINCIPLE 3</u> WHEN <u>CHILDREN</u> <u>CONTINUALLY</u> <u>DISOBEY</u>, THEY ARE IN <u>SIN</u>. WHEN <u>PARENTS</u> <u>CONTINUALLY</u> <u>REINFORCE</u> THAT <u>DISOBEDIENCE</u> BY <u>NOT</u> <u>REQUIRING</u> <u>OBEDIENCE</u>, THEY ARE IN <u>SIN</u>.
 - <u>Colossians 3:20-21</u> (NASB) Children, be <u>obedient</u> to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord. Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart.
 - a. THIS <u>SCRIPTURE</u> IS <u>NOT</u> A <u>SUGGESTION</u>!
 - Ephesians 6:1-2 (NASB) Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <u>HONOR</u> YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise),
 - a. THIS SCRIPTURE IS <u>NOT</u> A <u>SUGGESTION</u>... IT IS THE <u>5th</u> <u>COMMANDMENT</u>.
 - 3. <u>NOTE</u>: <u>OBBEDIENCE</u> AND <u>DISOBEDIENCE</u> ARE <u>MORAL</u> ACTS... <u>NOT</u> <u>INDIVIDUAL</u> <u>PREFERENCES</u>.
 - a. <u>JUDICIAL PARENTING</u> DOES <u>NOT</u> ALLOW <u>PARENTS</u> TO <u>REWARD</u> <u>SIN</u> BY <u>DOING NOTHING</u> <u>ABOUT</u> <u>IT</u>.

b. <u>PARENTS</u> MAY <u>OVERLOOK</u> <u>SMALL</u> <u>FAULTS</u>... <u>HOWEVER</u>, <u>PARENTS</u> SHOULD <u>NEVER</u> CONSIDER <u>WILLFUL</u> <u>DEFIANCE</u>... "<u>SMALL</u>".
