PARENTING BY THE BOOK "LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY"

1. **PRAYER**

- a. Robert Murray McShane once said, if you want to humble a Christian, just ask them about their prayer life.
- b. **Most** Christians, **if** they are **humble** and **self-aware**, will **admit** that they **struggle with prayer**.
- c. Prayer <u>humbles</u> us.
 - i. St. Teresa said, when it comes to prayer, we are all beginners.
- d. **BUT...** the <u>main reason</u> why most Christians would say I **struggle with** <u>prayer</u> is because we struggle to <u>PRIORITIZE</u> prayer in our daily lives.
- e. There are lots of **REASONS** for that:
 - i. One is **BUSSINESS**.
 - ii. Another is **DISTRACTIONS**.
 - 1. **Technology** Today, a virtual **conspiracy against the interior life**.
 - 2. There is a multi-billion-dollar industry whose **only goal** is to **monetize our attention**.
 - iii. Another is **CYNICISM**.
 - 1. Today everything can be **explained** by **science** and **physics** and **chance**.
 - a. And so even when God does answer <u>prayer</u>, we often think, well, was that just going to happen anyway?
 - b. Was that just a coincidence or karma?
 - iv. And finally, we **struggle** to <u>pray</u> because we <u>DON'T</u> <u>FEEL</u> <u>LIKE</u> <u>WE'RE</u> <u>GOOD</u> <u>AT</u> <u>IT</u>.
- f. We don't know where to start and we don't know what to say.

- 2. NOTE: In fairness, many of our religious traditions give us very little in the way of EQUIPPING us on HOW TO PRAY.
 - a. But for all of the above reasons, many Christians, for the most part, don't really pray very often.
 - We may value prayer... We may desire to pray...We may even believe in prayer... BUT WE DON'T PRAY.
- 3. This is a powerful statement... THERE IS NOTHING MORE IMPOPRIANT IN OUR SPIRITUAL LIFE THAN LEARNING TO PRAY.
 - a. <u>PRAYER</u> IS <u>NOT</u> A <u>PART</u> OF OUR SPIRITUAL LIFE... IT <u>IS</u> OUR SPIRITUAL LIFE!
 - b. That statement may cause you to **question** and think that is **extreme**... **BUT** if you will stay with me for a week or so, I'll do my best to **explain** what I mean.
- 4. <u>DISCUSS</u>: <u>WHAT IS PRAYER</u>... HOW WOULD YOU <u>DEFINE</u> IT?
 - a. **PRAYER** is an **umbrella term** in the Bible for **all kinds of ways of relating to God**.
 - b. The **definition** I like is that **PRAYER** IS THE **MEDIUM** THROUGH WHICH WE COMMUNICATE AND COMMUNE WITH GOD.
 - i. It's **NOT** just **TALKING TO GOD**... it's also **LISTENING TO GOD**.
 - c. We often think of **PRAYER** as a **MEANS** TO AN END.
 - i. WE ASK... GOD RESPONDS.
 - d. BUT, <u>PRAYER</u> (OUR LIFE WITH GOD) IS <u>NOT</u> A <u>MEANS</u> TO AN <u>END</u>...

 IT IS THE END!
 - i. Our whole <u>spiritual journey</u> is about <u>DEEPENING</u> <u>OUR</u> <u>LIFE</u>
 <u>WITH</u> <u>GOD</u>... AND THAT IS WHAT <u>PRAYER</u> IS:
 - 1. IT IS <u>ABIDING</u> IN A <u>LOVING</u> <u>RELATIONSHIP</u> <u>WITH</u> <u>GOD</u> BOTH <u>NOW</u> AND <u>FOREVER</u>.

- 2. THERE IS NOTHING MORE IMPORTANT!
- 3. AND WE NEED HELP TO PRAY WELL.
- 5. THE <u>DISCIPLES</u> WERE SELF-AWARE ENOUGH TO <u>KNOW</u> THAT <u>THEY</u> <u>NEEDED</u> <u>HELP</u> <u>WITH</u> <u>PRAYER</u>.
 - a. That's why they say to Jesus in <u>Luke 11:1</u>, "<u>LORD</u>, <u>TEACH</u> <u>US</u> <u>TO</u> <u>PRAY'</u>
 - b. THEY NEEDED HELP TO PRAY, AND I BELIEVE WE DO TOO.
 - i. That is why the verses in Luke 11:1-9 ARE SO IMPORTANT!
- 6. HERE IS AN OUTLINE OF WHERE WE ARE GOING IN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS:
 - a. Today we will look at **Luke 1:1-4**
 - i. THIS IS WHERE JESUS <u>TEACHES</u> US <u>HOW TO PRAY</u>.
 - **b.** Next week we will look at **Luke 1:5-13**
 - i. THIS IS WHERE JESUS <u>TEACHES</u> US ABOUT <u>WHY</u> <u>WE KEEP</u> <u>PRAYING</u>.
 - 1. BECAUSE <u>PRAYING IS HARD</u> AND WE OFTEN FEEL LIKE <u>GIVING UP</u>, WE ARE GOING TO TALK ABOUT <u>HOW TO BUILD A PRACTICE OF PRAYER</u>.
 - c. As we come to this teaching today, and next week, if our heart's desire is like the disciples, "LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY".
 - i. I believe... GOD WILL TEACH US TO PRAY.
 - ii. If we have receptive and eager hearts... GOD WILL TEACH USTO PRAY.
