1. REVIEW

- A. James 1:2-4 (NASB) Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.
- B. GOD DOES NOT ALLOW "TRIALS" TO MAKE US FALL, THEY ARE MEANT TO MAKE US SOAR,
 - 1. GOD DOES <u>NOT</u> ALLOW "<u>TRIALS</u>" TO <u>DEFEAT</u> US, THEY <u>ARE</u> MEANT TO <u>BE DEFEATED</u>,
 - 2. GOD DOES <u>NOT</u> ALLOW "<u>TRIALS</u>" TO MAKE US <u>WEAKER</u>, THEY <u>ARE</u> MEANT TO MAKE US <u>STRONGER</u>,
 - 3. THEREFORE, JAMES SAYS... WE SHOULD NOT COMPLAIN ABOUT "TRIALS"... WE SHOULD "<u>REJOICE</u>" <u>THROUGH</u> <u>THEM</u>.
- 1. THREE ESSENTIALS FOR VICTORY IN TRIALS:
 - A. THE <u>FIRST</u> <u>ESSENTIAL</u> ELEMENT FOR <u>VICTORY</u> IN <u>TRIALS</u> IS: <u>A JOYFUL</u> <u>ATTITUDE</u> ... "<u>CONSIDER</u> IT <u>ALL</u> <u>JOY</u> WHEN YOU ENCOUNTER <u>VARIOUS</u> <u>TRIALS</u>"...
 - 1. NOTE OUTLOOK DETERMINES OUTCOME AND ATTITUDE DETERMINES ACTION.
 - a. REMEMBER THAT WHEN WE <u>CHANGE</u> THE WAY WE <u>LOOK</u> AT <u>THINGS</u> ("<mark>TRIALS</mark>")... THE <u>THINGS</u> WE <u>LOOK</u> AT ("<mark>TRIALS</mark>") <u>CHANGE</u>!!
 - 2. <u>JAMES</u> TELLS US TO EXPECT TRIALS.
 - a. IT IS <u>NOT</u> A MATTER OF "<mark>IF</mark>" WE WILL "<u>ENCOUNTER VARIOUS</u> <u>TRIALS</u>", <u>BUT</u>... "<u>WHEN</u>" WE WILL "<u>ENCOUNTER VARIOUS</u> <u>TRIALS</u>".
 - b. THE <u>BELIEVER</u> WHO <u>EXPECTS</u> THEIR <u>CHRISTIAN LIFE</u> TO BE "<u>TRIAL</u>" <u>FREE</u> IS IN FOR A <u>SHOCK</u>.
 - 1) DISCUSS WHERE DID WE GET THE IDEA THAT WHEN WE BECAME CHRISTIANS OUR LIVES WOULD BE TROUBLE FREE?
 - 3. IF CHRISTIANS <u>LEARN</u> TO <u>ACCEPT</u> THAT "<u>TRIALS</u>" ARE A PART OF LIFE AND THAT GOD WILL <u>USE</u> "<u>TRIALS</u>" TO <u>MATURE</u> US... WE WILL <u>NOT</u> BE SO <u>SURPRIZED</u> WHEN THEY COME... AND THEN WE CAN <u>RESPOND</u> INSTEAD OF <u>REACTING</u>.
 - 4. A LOOK AT SOME <u>REASONS</u> WHY "TRIALS" COME IN CHRISTIANS LIVES:

- a. "TRIALS" COME BECAUSE OF THE <u>WORLD</u> WE LIIVE IN.
 - Ephesians 2:1-3 (NASB) And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world (WORLD), according to the prince of the power of the air (SATAN), of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh (FLESH), indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.
 - 2) THE <u>WORLD</u> WE LIVE IN <u>OPPOSES CHRISTIANS</u> AND THAT MAKES FOR A LIFE OF <u>TRIALS</u>.
- b. "<u>TRIALS</u>" COME BECAUSE WE ARE <u>HUMAN</u> (FLESH).
 - 1) <u>SICKNESS</u> AND <u>DEATH</u> ARE FACTS OF OUR <u>HUMANITY</u>.
 - 2) PRIDE CAUSES US TO MAKE BAD DECISIONS.
 - 3) <u>FOOLISHNESS</u> CAUSES US TO MAKE BAD DECISIONS.
 - 4) <u>ANGER</u> CAUSES US TO MAKE BAD DECISIONS.
 - 5) **REMEMBER** THERE ARE <u>CONSEQUENCES</u> FOR OUR BAD DECISIONS!
 - i. THOSE <u>CONSEQUENCES</u> ARE OFTEN IN THE <u>FORM</u> OF "<u>TRIALS</u>".
- c. "TRIALS" COME BECAUSE OF <u>SATAN</u> AND HIS <u>DEMONS</u>.
 - 1) <u>SATAN</u> AND HIS <u>DEMONS</u> <u>OPPOSE</u> OUR <u>SPIRITUAL</u> <u>GROWTH</u> BY <u>PERSONAL ATTACKS</u> AS WELL AS <u>USING</u> OUR <u>FLESH</u> AND THE <u>WORLD</u> <u>AGAINST</u> <u>US</u>.
 - i. **REMEMBER** TO SPEAK ALOUD..."I GIVE NO CONSENT TO THAT THOUGJT IN THE NAME OF MY SAVIOR, JESUS CHRIST."
- 5. <u>JAMES</u> SAYS <u>ALL</u> <u>TRIALS</u> ARE <u>NOT</u> <u>ALIKE</u>... THEY ARE "<u>VARIOUS</u>".
 - a. "... WHEN YOU ENCOUNTER VARIOUS TRIALS".
 - b. <u>WIERSBE</u> SAYS OUR <u>TRIALS</u> ARE LIKE <u>VARIGATED</u> (MULTI-COLORED, NOT THE SAME) <u>YARN</u> THAT A <u>WEAVER</u> USES TO MAKE A <u>RUG</u>.
 - c. CORRIE ten BOOM WROTE:

My life is but a weaving Between my God and me. I cannot choose the colors He weaveth steadily.

Oft' times He weaveth sorrow;

And I in foolish pride Forget He sees the upper And I the underside.

Not 'til the loom is silent And the shuttles cease to fly Will God unroll the canvas And reveal the reason why.

The dark threads are as needful In the weaver's skillful hand As the threads of gold and silver In the pattern He has planned

He knows, He loves, He cares; Nothing this truth can dim. He gives the very best to those Who leave the choice to Him.

6. "<u>CONSIDER</u>" IS A <u>KEY WORD</u> IN THIS PASSAGE.

- a. IT MEANS "TO EVALUATE", "TO THINK ABOUT", "BE AWARE OF".
 - 1) JAMES SAYS THAT WE SHOULD EXPECT "VARIOUS TRIALS"AND "WHEN" WE DO, WE SHOULD "EVALUATE/BE AWARE OF" THOSE "TRIALS" IN LIGHT OF WHAT GOD IS DOING FOR AND IN US.

b. NOTE OUR VALUES DETERMINE OUR EVALUATIONS:

- 1) <u>IF</u> WE "<u>VALUE</u>" <u>COMFORT MORE</u> THAN <u>CHARACTER</u>, THEN "<u>TRIALS</u>" <u>WILL SURPRISE</u> AND <u>UPSET</u> US.
- 2) IF WE "VALUE" THE MATERIAL AND PHYSICAL MORE THAN THE <u>SPIRITUAL</u>, THEN WE WILL <u>NOT</u> BE ABLE TO "<u>COUNT</u> IT <u>ALL JOY</u>" <u>WHEN</u> WE ENCOUNTER VARIOUS "<u>TRIALS</u>".
- 3) <mark>IF</mark> WE LIVE <mark>ONLY</mark> FOR THE <u>PRESENT</u>, THEN "<mark>TRIALS</mark>" <u>WILL</u> MAKE US <u>BITTER</u> INSTEAD OF <u>BETTER</u>.
- c. REMEMBER OUTLOOK DETERMINES OUTCOME.

- 1) THEREFORE TO END WITH "JOY"... WE NEEDTO BEGIN WITH "JOY".
- d. QUESTION?... DOES THIS HELP YOU TO <u>UNDERSTAND</u> <u>HOW</u> IS IT <u>POSSIBLE</u> TO "<u>REJOICE</u>" IN THE <u>MIDST</u> OF "<u>TRIALS</u>"?
- e. THE <u>SECOND</u> <u>ESSENTIAL</u> FOR <u>VICTORY</u> IN "<u>TRIALS</u>" <u>HELPS</u> TO <u>EXPLAIN</u> THIS.
- B. THE <u>SECOND</u> ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR <u>VICTORY</u> IN <u>TRIALS</u> IS: "AN <u>UNDERSTANDING MIND</u>... "<u>KNOWING</u> THAT THE <u>TESTING</u> OF YOUR FAITH PRODUCES <u>INDURANCE</u>.
 - 1. BY "<u>KNOWING</u>" THAT GOD HAS A <u>GREATER PURPOSE</u> IN THE "<u>TRIAL</u>" BELIEVERS CAN <u>ULTIMATELY</u> "<u>CONSIDER</u> <u>IT</u> <u>ALL</u> <u>JOY</u>".
 - a. FOR MOST OF US "<u>JOY</u>" IS <u>NOT</u> OUR <u>FIRST</u> <u>RESPONSE</u> TO "<u>TRIALS</u>".
 - 2. WHAT SHOULD <u>CHRISTIANS</u> "<u>KNOW</u>" THAT MAKES IT <u>EASIER</u> TO <u>TURN</u> <u>TRIALS</u> INTO <u>TRIUMPHS</u>?...
 - a. WE SHOULD "<u>KNOW</u>" THAT <u>FAITH</u> IS <u>ALWAS</u> <u>TESTED</u>.
 - 1) GOD <u>ALLOWS</u> "TRIALS" TO INCREASE OUR FAITH.
 - 2) <u>GOD ALLOWS</u> "<u>TRIALS</u>" TO BRING OUT THE <u>BEST</u>... <u>SATAN</u> <u>TEMPTS</u> US TO BRING OUT THE <u>WORST</u>.
 - 3) WE SHOULD "<u>KNOW</u>" THAT THE "<u>TESTING OF</u> <u>OUR</u> <u>FAITH</u>" ACTUALLY <u>PROVES</u> THAT WE ARE <u>BORN AGAIN</u>.
 - b. WE SHOULD "<mark>KNOW</mark>" THAT "TRIALS" WORK FOR US, NOT AGAINST <u>US BECAUSE</u> OF <u>SCRIPTURE</u>:
 - <u>Romans 8:28</u> (NASB) And we <u>know</u> that God causes all things to work together for good to <u>those</u> who love God, to <u>those</u> who are <u>called according to His purpose</u>.
 - 2) <u>2 Corinthians 4:17-18</u> (NASB) For <u>momentary</u>, <u>light affliction</u> is producing for us an <u>eternal weight</u> of glory far beyond all comparison, while we look <u>not</u> at the <u>things</u> which are <u>seen</u>, but

at the <u>things</u> which are <u>not seen</u>; for the <u>things</u> which are <u>seen</u> are <u>temporal</u>, but the <u>things</u> which are <u>not seen</u> are <u>eternal</u>.

- i. <u>MOMENTARY</u>... <u>LIGHT AFFLICTION</u>. VERSUS...
 - 1. ETERNAL... WEIGHT OF GLORY.
- ii. THINGS <u>SEEN</u>... <u>TEMPORAL</u>. VERSUS...
 - 1. THINGS NOT SEEN ... ETERNAL.
- c. CHRISTIANS SHOULD "<u>KNOW</u>" THAT "<u>TRIALS</u>" <u>RIGHTLY USED</u> HELP US TO <u>MATURE</u>.
 - <u>Romans 5:3-5</u> (NASB) And not only this, but we also exult (= "JOY") in our <u>tribulations</u> ("<u>TRIALS</u>"), <u>knowing</u> that <u>tribulation</u> (<u>TRIALS</u>)brings about <u>perseverance</u>; and perseverance, proven <u>character</u>; and proven character, <u>hope</u>; and hope does <u>not</u> <u>disappoint</u>, because the <u>love of God</u> has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
- 3. THE "<mark>TESTING</mark> OF FAITH" HERE IS NOT INTENDED TO DETERMINE</mark> WHETHER A PERSON HAS "FAITH" OR NOT... IT IS INTENDED TO PURIFY AND <u>STRENGTHEN</u> THE "FAITH" THAT <u>ALREADY</u> EXISTS.
- 4. ANOTHER WORD FOR "ENDURANCE" (NASB) IS "PATIENCE" (KJV, NKJV)
 - a. THE <u>GREEK WORD</u> FOR "<u>ENDURANCE</u>/<u>PATIENCE</u>" PAINTS A <u>WORD</u> <u>PICTURE</u> OF THE <u>QUALITY</u> THAT IT TAKES FOR A <u>RUNNER</u> TO <u>FINISH</u> A <u>MARATHON</u>.
 - 1) NOTE THE <u>GOAL</u> OF "<u>TRIALS</u>" IS <u>NOT</u> TO <u>SNAP</u> OUR <u>FAITH</u> <u>MUSCLES</u>... <u>BUT</u>, TO <u>STRETCH</u> AND <u>STRENGTHEN</u> OUR FAITH MUSCLES <u>PRODUCING</u> "<u>ENDURANCE</u>" TO <u>FINISH</u> THE <u>RACE</u>.
 - i. THE ABILITY TO "<u>HANG IN THERE</u>".

- B. THE <u>SECOND</u> <u>ESSENTIAL</u> ELEMENT FOR <u>VICTORY</u> IN <u>TRIALS</u> IS: "AN <u>UNDERSTANDING MIND</u>... "KNOWING THAT THE <u>TESTING</u> OF YOUR FAITH PRODUCES <u>INDURANCE</u>.
- C. THE <u>THIRD</u> ESSENTIAL ELEMENT FOR <u>VICTORY</u> IN <u>TRIALS</u> IS: <u>A</u> <u>SURRENDERED</u> <u>WILL</u>... "<u>LET</u> ENDURANCE HAVE IT'S PERFECT RESULT SO THAT YOU MAY BE PERFECT AND COMPLETE LACKING IN NOTHING"... A <u>SURRENDERED</u> <u>WILL</u>.
