The 205th Anniversary of **Shelbyville First Baptist Church**



First Baptist Church of Shelbyville, KY was constituted at the courthouse on Saturday morning, January 23, 1819.

The original church building was constructed in 1819 at the northeast corner of Eighth and Clay Streets. The church building at left was erected in 1859 at

Fifth and Main Streets but destroyed by fire in 1909. The church was rebuilt on the same site and dedicated in 1912. The ceiling of this building collapsed in 1958 and was declared unsafe. The first building at our current site was dedicated November 1, 1959.

We reflect a strong legacy as we look to the past. We celebrate today, and anticipate that God will do great things in the future.

AHG girls participate in badge programs, service projects, leadership opportunities, and outdoor experiences, all with an emphasis on Christian values and family involvement.




