I would like to start by sending my sincerest apologies. The summer came rolling in fast and, before I knew it, I was looking at my calendar realizing its already September and I haven't sent out a newsletter in months. Over the past few months our family has been extremely busy with course work as well as schooling. I successfully completed Hebrew (thank you for all the prayers!) and went straight into a new semester of work. Rachel chose to start school with the children in the beginning of July in anticipation of finishing a bit early in the Spring.

We did not have the opportunity to do any traveling over the summer due to my course work, but that didn't prevent us from having a great time! Thankfully, the weather here was very mild this summer and we were able to get outside at different parks and local play areas as well as going on our first family camping trip.

The children are enjoying being part of the seminary soccer league this fall which gets them engaged with their friends and provides a fun outlet for them to partake in team sports!



JUSTIFIED:

One of the beautiful discoveries Martin Luther made that led him to rethink his monastic life was that of Justification. He spent many years struggling with the feeling that nothing he could do would make him right before God. As he grew closer to the Word of God, passages such as Ephesians 2:8 - "For by grace you have been saved, through faith. And this is not of your own doing; it is the gift of God."-Stood out to him and brought him to have confidence in the saving work of his baptism. We too can find confidence in knowing that our justification comes through Christ, not our own works. Whenever we may be tempted to despair over our salvation, we need to lean on the promise of our Baptism: we are covered by the blood of Christ (Ephesians 1:7)!



Perhaps the biggest thing that has just taken place is the fact that I am no longer on Active duty! As of October 1st, I have been honorably discharged. I will be swearing into the chaplain candidacy program on October 5th. In this program, I will have the opportunity to receive the chaplaincy training through the Navy incase God calls me back to active duty. However, it is a nocontract program so, if God leads me in a different direction, I will not have any obligated service.

I cannot thank you all enough for the prayers you prayed on my behalf over the past year. I have very clearly seen God's hand throughout this entire process and feel extremely relieved to be able to focus on my schoolwork rather than trying to balance school with the separations process. We are now attending Vicarage meetings which is a crazy prospect. It is hard to believe we have been here for over a year and are nearing the halfway point of my sixth semester at the Seminary. We are praying that God will guide us in the direction He wills and place us in a congregation that will help us grow in our ministry as well as one that we can also be a blessing to.

I realize that I have been asking for prayers from you all, but I also want to extend the invitation for you to send prayers to us! We pray for you all, regularly, but would love to be able to pray for your specific needs. Please feel free to reach out to us with any prayer requests you may have and we would be happy to bring them before the Lord. Thank you again for all of your love and support, we could not do this without you!

All three of the children are growing up so quickly! Rachel is working with John and Ruth to memorize Philippians chapter 4!

The backpack food ministry continues to provide weekly food bags for approximately 26 students at Holm Elementary. We are flexible with this number as we can provide for up to about 50 students but we leave it to the staff and teachers of Holm to identify the students needing food assistance over the weekend.

We will also be filling food baskets in December to assist 12 families that are identified by Holm staff. We will soon be asking for the donation of a ham or the funds to purchase one which will go with each one of these baskets. You should be seeing a sign-up sheet in the Welcome center by mid-November. We will deliver the Christmas baskets and hams mid-December to Holm Elementary.


