# - God intentionally creates humans as MALE AND FEMALE.

The Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him." (Genesis 2:18, NIV)

"What changed God's not good to very good? The difference was the creation of two genders . . . God made us male and female because fundamentally, we need each other." – Michael Nolen

- How has the enemy used culture to cause us to blame the other gender for the world's problems?
- What are some practical expressions of these beliefs in our marriages? In our parenting? In our work relationships?
