- Why doesn't the culture allow room for nuance?

# 4 Truths in This Passage

- God created sexual identity
- When God created sexual identity, He created male & female
- God created sexual intimacy
- That intimacy is supposed to be between husband & wife in marriage
  - Which of these 4 is the hardest for our culture to accept? Why?

### Point 1. What does God's Word say about homosexuality?

Last week we talked about Imago Dei being "pre-political" - something in place prior to any state or politics. Sexual identity (as with the value of life last week) are primarily theological issues, not political ones. When the state takes theological issues and makes political declarations about them, they will turn around and say that Christians cannot talk about them because it's a political issue. But they were theological issues first.

- How do we answer these objections?
- Why is it important to know how God created humanity, in order, to understand these issues?
- Why is it hard to listen to what the bible says over cultural pressures?

Are there commands against homosexuality in both the New and Old Testament?

- Do we dismiss the OT commands (Lev. 18:22, 20:13) because we are in the new covenant and no longer under OT laws?
- What would you say to someone who says that homosexuality is OK because Jesus never prohibited it directly?
- What is the danger of pro-homosexual Christian leaders saying, "God has not spoken clearly on this issue, and we're the first generation in history to figure that out"?
- Discuss how culture changes but the truth of God's Word does not.

## Point 2. What do I do if same-sex attraction is a part of my life?

This is the one I esteem: he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and trembles at my word. (Isaiah 66:2)

Discuss what it means to be humble, contrite and tremble at His Word on this issue?

"The core issue is never sexual...It's the attitude toward God behind our sexuality: We want to establish what is right. We want to be God. We want to judge rather than be judged. We want to remake reality around our preferences. It is not homosexuality that condemns; it is the sin behind that sin that condemns." - Rosaria Butterfield

- Is homosexuality itself a salvation issue?
- Can you be saved if you struggle with same-sex attraction?
- Discuss why our sexual preferences are not salvation issues, but our attitude toward God about ALL sin of which homosexuality may be one of many.

"We have to love our gay neighbor more than we love our position on sexual morality."

• Discuss with the group ways to show love & grace to your same-sex attracted friends while still holding to biblical truths.

"Remember that sexual ethics are not the center of Christianity." "Does this biblical teaching on sexuality bother you? Well, then punt it for a while... because the center of Christianity is not sexual ethics: the cross and Lordship of Jesus are." - C.S. Lewis

- Why is it so important to make the Lordship of Christ the most important issue?
- Why is it so important not to let our sexuality define who we are as a person?
