

PREFACE

This devotional booklet is designed for elementary-aged children and the parents/ guardians who want to help guide them through the fast on their level. This is an excellent opportunity to encourage children to experience Christ's presence through prayer and fasting under the watchful care and guidance of their guardians.

By introducing children to fasting at an early age, we help them understand and practice an important spiritual discipline that Jesus modeled. This helps them become authentic followers of Jesus. Whether you are new to fasting or have done it for years, know that it is okay to not have all the answers to your kids' questions. Stick to the basics, use the tips and tricks below, and don't hesitate to reach out to the children's ministry at your church for help and advice!

- Focus on God: Fasting is a way to focus on God and put him first.
- **Do it willingly**: Fasting is a discipline we willingly practice to grow closer to God.
- **Start small**: This booklet has material for a 10-day fast (rather than a 40-day fast) to encourage children's success, starting with a short-term fast they will likely be able to maintain.
- **Be an example**: Children will learn and understand more if you model biblical fasting for them.
- Be gentle, patient, and encouraging: Allow children to participate in ageappropriate ways and gently encourage them to go deeper. It will lay a foundation for more meaningful experiences in the future.
- Let the children pick:
 - A specific need to pray about: Encourage children to identify and
 write down a specific need, concern, or issue to focus on and refer to
 throughout their time of prayer and fasting. When they have a chance to
 give input, they're more likely to want to participate.
 - A specific item to fast from: Help them choose what to fast from (sweets, video games, screen time, a favorite food, etc.).

- Something to replace that fasted item with: Help them make different choices. For example,
 - If they choose to fast from candy, help them choose vegetables and fruits instead and spend time in prayer before eating.
 - If they are fasting from screen time, help them use the time wisely
 by filling up the empty time with something that helps focus on God
 and our relationship with Him. For example, consider taking that 20
 minutes to read a Bible story and pray together instead! (Consider
 sharing the stories of Daniel, Paul, Anna, Esther, Moses, and Elijah
 with them to help understand the purpose and benefits of fasting).
- **Help them remember the focus**: Fasting isn't for a prize, reward, or treat. It's to grow our relationship with God. Give children positive, encouraging input and feedback.


