# II. New Term Kickoff/Administration

- Staff/Elder relationships
  - Reminder of the purpose Our role is to come alongside to encourage, support, pray.
    Check the Elder Handbook for details. NOT a supervisory or directive relationship. Any conflict or issues...please point to the proper staff channels. The process is stated in the Elder Handbook.
  - What types of conversations are you having?
    - o Prayer life? Devotional life? Marriage? What are you struggling with?
    - One staff member really appreciates the intentionality of being pursued.
    - Consistency and intentionality of caring for staff.
    - o Is there anything that is lacking clarity of what the elders are working on?
  - Tyler will send out the Elder Handbook. It will be revised in the next few months. Please read and make note of changes that might needed for when we discuss at a future date.
  - Elders and Staff pairings were affirmed/confirmed.

We reviewed a list of potential Rising Leaders. Tyler will send the list out and we will finalize the names and pairings at our next meeting.

One possibility is to target potential 1 year Rising Leaders (who were heavily involved in leadership at another church, so the purpose is alignment). They could be used in future multiplication contexts.

- Review of protocol/expectations
  - Agenda setting. Tyler, as chair, is an organizer of agenda items.
  - Role of BLT Board Leadership Team. They meet together to discern what the pressing issues are for the board to wrestle with. Key issues that should be brought to the board. Shouldn't be decisions made by this smaller group.
    - Caution make sure there isn't a board within the board.
      - Ex Leadership transitions
    - If there is reservation or concerns that things are moving too fast...Please feel the freedom to hit a pause button!
    - Very intentionally thinking through the leadership succession. We need to be thinking about the Chair and the Treasurer roles several years out.
  - We are certainly able to and encouraged to send emails...Food for thought, articles, etc. But we aren't expected to reply all and make motions/decisions via email.
- What's ahead for this term?
  - Elder Handbook re-vamp
  - How does the elder board scale to serve a growing church?
  - Updates on Mobilization and Teacher Pathway
  - Retreat What does the future look like?
    - o Long term capacity on our campus. Number of services, etc.
    - Multiplication / Church in a box.
  - Staff at the Elder retreat will be re-reading Sticky Teams. We would join them! More specific feedback on this coming soon.
  - Job Descriptions, Hirings, We need to revisit the process.
  - How can we be known as the shepherds of a growing congregation?

#### III. Pastoral Updates:

- Staff Update
  - Julie Reed (Early Childhood Coordinator) is stepping down at the end of June.
  - Charity Englehart (Youth Admin) is stepping down in August.
  - Sandy Morris was hired as the Disability Coordinator.
- Immanuel update
