Each applicant must submit an original essay which will aid the committee in making award decisions. The following points may be addressed, along with others of your choosing.

- 1. Why do you wish to attend an institution of higher education?
- 2. What do you want to accomplish in the next 4 years? 10 years?
- 3. What / who have been major influences in your life (other than family members)?
- 4. What role do you see the church playing in your life both to date and in the future?

Structure and Form:

- 1. Length and Format. Papers may be anywhere between 750 and 1500 words in length. This is the equivalent of 3 to 6 typed, double-spaced pages. All papers must be typed and double-spaced. Handwritten essays will not be considered. Two copies of the essay must be submitted.
- 2. Sincerity. Applications will be judged, in part, on the qualities of sincerity.
- 3. Originality. Content should be in the writer's own words and style.
- 4. Consistency of Theme.
- **5. Composition.** Scoring will consider the writer's use of language, grammar, spelling and punctuation.
- **6. Illustrations.** At your option, you may include photos, illustrations, or other graphics / media which will help the readers know you better.
