

## How the Gospel Shapes the Way We Serve September 1, 2024 | 1 Thessalonians1:1-12 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

\*\* Before you begin, please read 1 Thessalonians1:1-12

- 1. Icebreaker: Share a time when your gifts, wisdom, and/or time were used to serve someone around you. How did this make you feel? What difference did it make?
- 2. Why is serving others important?
- 3. What makes serving others hard?
- 4. Read Ephesians 4:11-12, then answer the following questions.
  - Who is equipped for service in verse 12?
  - What results from these works of service, according to the end of verse 12?
  - In your own words, explain how this verse underlines the importance of every follower of Jesus Christ using their gifts to serve others.
- 5. Practice careful observation of 1 Thessalonians 2:1-12 and make a list of everything you read there that characterizes Paul's ministry to the Thessalonians.
- 6. Which of these observations (see previous question) stands out to you most? Why?
- 7. Work back through your list of observations from 1 Thessalonians 2:1-12. For each, share what it would look like in practical terms to live and serve like this today.
- 8. What have you learned from 1 Thessalonians 2:1-12 about how the gospel shapes our service of others? In what practical ways can this affect why and how you serve?
- 9. Describe someone whose life is characterized by many of the same "approaches to ministry / service" that you read about in 1 Thessalonians 2:1-12. What does this value of service look like in their life, as it is lived out there?
- 10. Are you serving others in a consistent way right now? If yes, what are you doing and how is it making a difference in you? If no, what is keeping you from doing this?
- 11. What other questions or comments do you have about what you've looked at in the Bible today?
- 12. What is your biggest take-away from what you've discussed so far? What practical step will you take to apply what you've seen in God's Word?
