

## Kingdom Priorities: What Matters Most? October 6, 2024 | Select Scriptures Questions for Study and Group Discussion

- 1. Icebreaker: Write a brief headline summarizing your life this last week. What does it say?
- 2. Share 2-3 headlines that have come across your newsfeed in the last 7-10 days that have grabbed your attention the most. Why do these stand out to you?
- 3. In the midst of news or events that can create alarm, fear, or anxiety, why is it important to keep the big picture godly perspective in mind?
- 4. Read Matthew 6:33. What does this verse say should be our focus? In your own words, what does this mean?
- 5. Matthew 22:36-40 (the Great Commandment) and Matthew 22:18-20 (the Great Commission) provide instruction on how to live with a kingdom perspective. These passages are the focus of the questions below.
  - Read Matthew 22:36-40. What take-aways do you have from this passage that should shape how you live with a kingdom perspective? (Extra credit: Read Luke 10:25-37) and share what it adds to your understanding of Matthew 22:36-40.)
  - Read Matthew 28:18-20. What take-aways do you have from this passage that should shape how you live with a kingdom perspective?
- 6. Three steps of practical application were provided in the sermon. Briefly summarize each one, and share how this step of application can take specific shape in your life.
  - Be engaged.
  - Be wise.
  - Stand out in hope.
- 7. What other questions or comments do you have about what you've looked at in the Bible today?
- 8. What is your biggest take-away from what you've discussed so far? What practical step will you take to apply what you've seen in God's Word?
- 9. **Challenge:** Identify one way this passage is challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you're learning this coming week?
- 10. **Challenge:** Memorize Matthew 6:33 "Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."
