

When Quiet is Loud October 20, 2024 | 1 Thessalonians 4:9-12 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

** Before you begin, please read 1 Thessalonians 4:9-12

- 1. Icebreaker: Share a time in your life when a seemingly small action made a big, disproportionate difference.
- 2. 1 Thessalonians 4:9-10 highlights the importance of love that Christians are to show one another. Read the following passages and discuss what they add to your understanding of biblical love:
 - John 13:34-35
 - 1 Corinthians 13:4-7
 - 1 John 4:7-12
- 3. Why do you think Paul urges the Thessalonians to love this way "more and more" even if it's something they were already doing?
- 4. In 1 Thessalonians 4:11-12, Paul also highlights the value of "quiet living." Using language straight from these verses, what does this look like (v.11) and what does difference can this make (v. 12)?
- 5. What might this sort of "quiet living" look like today, in your life?
- 6. Does v. 12 mean Christians shouldn't be vocal about their faith or take firm stands on biblically-faithful convictions? Explain your answer.
- 7. Describe someone you know whose life is marked by the love and faithfulness we read about in 1 Thessalonians 4:9-12. How does their "quiet living" make a "loud difference" for Jesus?
- 8. What was your biggest take-away from the message? Why?
- 9. Imagine your life in light of what you read in the Bible and heard in the message:
 - What would your life look like, living in line with what you've learned from God's Word?
 - What are the biggest challenges you anticipate, as you think about living in line with what you've learned?
 - Is there a specific situation in your life right now, where truth from this passage shapes how you live / think / relate with others?
 - What is one way you can practically apply what you learned this week?
- 10. **Challenge:** Identify one way this passage is challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you're learning this coming week?
