

Where's Your Treasure? March 2, 2025 | Matthew 6:19-24 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

** Before you begin, please read Matthew 6:19-24.

- 1. **Ice-breaker:** Would you consider yourself more of a saver or a spender? What's one difficult thing you've had to stretch yourself to save up for?
- 2. Look at Matthew 6:19. What does it look like in practical terms to "store up treasures on earth?" Why does this verse say this is unwise?
- 3. Does this mean it's wrong to save or have personal possessions beyond the bare minimum? Explain your answer.
- 4. What does it mean to "store up treasures in heaven" in Matthew 6:20?
- 5. Read Matthew 22:36-40. What priorities does this passage give us? How can this provide insight into what it means to "store up treasures in heaven"?
- 6. Read Matthew 6:21 out loud. How does this verse underline the importance of thinking rightly about money?
- 7. From Matthew 6:24, what does it look like to have money as a god? Is this still a temptation around us today? Explain.
- 8. What other questions or comments do you have about what you've looked at in the Bible today?
- 9. What was your biggest take-away from the message? Why?
- 10. **Challenge:** Identify one way this passage is challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you're learning this coming week?
- 11. Challenge | Memorize Matthew 6:21: "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."
