Questions for Study and Group Discussion**

*** Before you begin, please read Matthew 6:19-24.*

1. **Ice-breaker:** Would you consider yourself more of a saver or a spender? What's one difficult thing you've had to stretch yourself to save up for?
2. Look at Matthew 6:19. What does it look like in practical terms to "store up treasures on earth?" Why does this verse say this is unwise?
3. Does this mean it's wrong to save or have personal possessions beyond the bare minimum? Explain your answer.
4. What does it mean to "store up treasures in heaven" in Matthew 6:20?
5. Read Matthew 22:36-40. What priorities does this passage give us? How can this provide insight into what it means to "store up treasures in heaven"?
6. Read Matthew 6:21 out loud. How does this verse underline the importance of thinking rightly about money?
7. From Matthew 6:24, what does it look like to have money as a god? Is this still a temptation around us today? Explain.
8. What other questions or comments do you have about what you've looked at in the Bible today?
9. What was your biggest take-away from the message? Why?
10. **Challenge:** Identify one way this passage is challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you're learning this coming week?
11. **Challenge | Memorize Matthew 6:21:** "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."
