

# In the Wilderness July 13, 2025 | Psalm 63:1-11 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

Take time as a group to read through Psalm 63.

1. Have you ever been or are you currently in a wilderness season? How would you describe your wilderness season?

# In the Wilderness: Acknowledge who God is.

- 1. In verse 1, David declares who God is. Why can it be so hard to remember who God is when life is difficult?
- 2. What does it mean that God is your possession? Why is it so important to remember that God belongs to you when you are in the wilderness?

# In the Wilderness: Desire God Above All Things

- 1. How does David's thirst for God during hardship show the depth of his desire for Him?
- 2. What things do you run to when life gets hard? Why do you run to these things instead of God?
- 3. How have you seen God's glory and power in your life? How have you experienced God's love?
- 4. Do you desire for God to get you out of the wilderness more than you desire God in the wilderness?

### In the Wilderness: Remember the Faithfulness of God

- 1. Why is remembering God's faithfulness important when facing hard circumstances?
- 2. How has God been your help?

#### In the Wilderness: Praise God

- 1. Do you have a hard time praising God in the wilderness? Why do you think that is?
- 2. What would it look like for you to be a person that praises God in the good and the bad?

# In the Wilderness: Complete Confidence in God

- 1. Read 2 Samuel 7:11-13. Why is David so confident that God will deliver him from his enemies?
- 2. Where does your confidence lie? Is it in the victory of Christ or does your confidence lie in yourself?
