

How Majestic is Your Name in All the Earth Psalm 8 August 3, 2025 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

**Before you begin, please read Psalm 8 as a group.

Ice breaker: Describe a time when you experienced God's presence and comfort through a Psalm or scripture during a difficult season? What was that experience like?

- 1. Psalm 8 reminds us that we serve a Big God. What does it mean to serve a Big God, and how might that influence your perspective on life's challenges?
- 2. The sermon highlights that "God uses our weakness to display His Glory." Can you share a personal experience where God's strength was made evident through a time of weakness or vulnerability?
- 3. The Psalms teach honesty with God, coming to Him at your best or your worst. What might it look like to be truly open and authentic with God in prayer? What might be holding you back from doing so more consistently?
- 4. Psalm 8 transitions from awe at creation to the rhetorical question: "What is mankind that you are mindful of them?". How does this perspective, contrasting human insignificance with God's intentional care, connect with your personal understanding of your own value and purpose?
- 5. Thinking about Brookside Church and its campuses, how can a church family embody the message of Psalm 8 by recognizing and affirming the value and dignity of everyone God has placed in our lives?
- 6. Considering the sermon's points about God's greatness, our purpose, and Jesus' fulfillment of Psalm 8, what is one specific step you could take this week to live out these truths in their daily life?
- 7. **Challenge:** Memorize Psalm 8:1 ¹Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory in the heavens.
