



## **Ehud: The Right Man for What's Needed**

### **Questions for Study and Group Discussion**

*\*\* Before you begin, please read Judges 3:12-30 as a group.*

1. Icebreaker: This story of Ehud contains many memorable elements. Which detail “grabs” you the most? Why?
2. The book of Judges repeats a “sin cycle” numerous times — this cycle includes disobedience, defeat, despair, dependence, and deliverance. How do you see the stages of this cycle “mapped” onto Judges 3:12-30? (Connect the stages of the cycle with specific verses in this passage.)
3. How does Ehud’s deliverance of Israel from Moabite rule show evidence of careful planning?
4. How does Ehud leverage his left-handedness in this story?
5. What unique skills has God given you? What are key relationships you’re in? In what situations has God given you influence? How can you steward these skills, relationships, and/or situations for God’s glory and the good of others?
6. One take-away from this story is that we must not overlook God’s amazing grace. Where do you see God’s grace on display in this passage?
7. Read Romans 5:6-8 and Ephesians 2:1-10 — passages that highlight God’s amazing grace. What should our response be to this grace?
8. Practically speaking, what can you do to apply something you read from this passage or heard in the sermon?
9. What other questions or comments do you have about what you’ve looked at in the Bible today?
10. What was your biggest take-away from the message? Why?
