Questions for Study and Group Discussion

1. Icebreaker: Spend some time sharing any notable Father's Day memories – maybe something you did for your dad growing up, ways you're spending Father's Day this year, etc.
2. Why is it important to celebrate dads and acknowledge their influence? How can you encourage your dad or an influential male figure in your life this coming week?
3. Read Judges 13:1-5. What do you learn about Samson's calling from God in these verses?
4. Read Judges 16:1-21. How do you see Samson disregarding his calling here and ultimately getting undone through compromise?
5. "Samson's biggest foe wasn't the Philistines or Delilah. Samson's biggest foe was himself." Do you agree with this statement? Explain your answer.
6. A main point of Samson's story is that God's power is greatest in people who know they need Him the most. How do you see this truth on display in Samon's story?
7. What is one area of need in your life right now, where you've been depending on your own strength? What can it look like for you to depend on God in this area?
8. Practically speaking, what can you do to apply something you read from this passage or heard in the sermon?
9. What other questions or comments do you have about what you've looked at in the Bible today?
10. What was your biggest take-away from the message? Why?
11. What big take-aways are you leaving with from this series on the book of Judges that we've been studying for the last 6 weeks?
