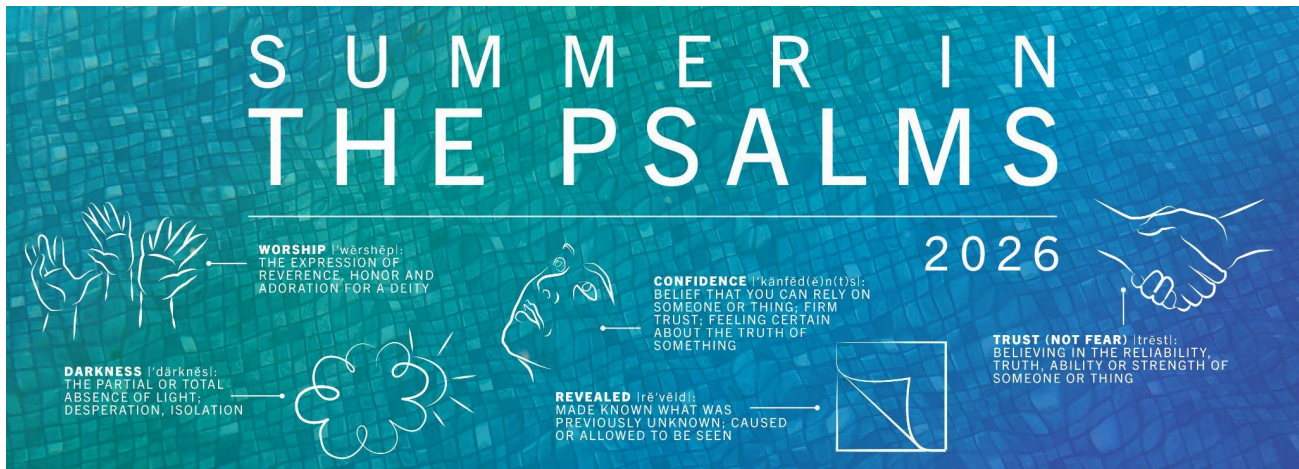




Psalm 19: God Revealed

Questions for Study and Group Discussion

1. What is something in your life that has become more understandable and clearer as you've lived?
2. Share a memory of a place in creation that has left you in awe (a mountain, beach, starry night, storm, etc.). In what ways do these moments reveal God?
3. As God reveals himself, it brings him and his character into clearer focus. Where have you experienced God and his character becoming clearer to you over time?
4. Read Psalm 19:1–6. What words or images does David use to describe how creation reveals God? According to these verses, what does creation communicate, and what doesn't it communicate about God?
 - What are some attributes about God that only Scripture can reveal?
5. Read Psalm 19:7–11. What descriptions does David give of God's Word, and what effects does he say it has on those who receive it? Which pairing (for example, "perfect...refreshing the soul") stands out most to you, and why?
6. David says God's Word is "more precious than gold" and "sweeter than honey." What competes for that place of value in your own heart? How can you cultivate a greater appreciation for God's Word?
7. In what ways does Psalm 19 ultimately point us toward our need for Jesus?
8. How can we respond to God revealing himself to us? What role do we play in revealing and sharing Christ with others?
