## Serving at the Kid's Clothing Center ADVANCE NOTES FOR PARENTS

Please read before the zoom training

## **Parameters**

- Kids serving at the Kid's Clothing Center must be age 10-15 (see below for kids older than 15).
- No more than 1-2 kids (age 10-15) per shift will be scheduled.
- One kid per family, per shift.

## Parents,

Before the training, please have the following conversation with your child, who is currently serving with you at the Kid's Clothing Center.

- Invite them to the training as a leader and example for those kids that aren't plugged in yet.
- Tell them that at the training, we won't be teaching them how to do the laundry, how to straighten the store or how to run the register (they most likely know all that!)
- Instead, we will be talking about how serving others at the Kid's Clothing Center revolves around our Core Values:
  - o All People Matter To God
    - What kinds of people do we serve at the Kid's Clothing Center and why is that important?
    - What is poverty?
    - How can we provide dignity to our guests with the clothes and our attitudes?
  - o Intentional Relationships
    - Why are intentional relationships important?
    - How is the Kid's Clothing Center about more than just the clothes?
    - How does making friends and being kind honor God?

- After the training, unpack what they may have learned. Good questions are:
  - "Did anything surprise you?"
  - "What stood out to you?"
  - "Did you learn anything that you didn't already know?"
  - Do you know anyone at school that doesn't seem to have enough?
  - Could you relate to what was being said because you've worked in the Kid's Clothing Center?
