**STAY AWHILE AN ADVENT STUDY** Join us on Sundays at 9:30am for our intergenerational Sunday School. Advent, a season of preparation - like our holiday gatherings - takes time and care. - End-of-Year Giving reminder: The IRS requires the church receive checks/stocks in 2024 to be counted as a 2024 contribution. If delivered in person, the check must be received in the office by 1pm, December 31, 2024, or in 10:30am worship on December 29. If mailed, your check must be dated 2024, and your envelope postmarked by December 31, 2024. Checks dated in 2024, but postmarked in 2025 must be credited, for IRS purposes in 2025.
