If delivered in person, it must be received in the office by 1pm, December 31, 2024, or in 10:30am worship on December 29. If mailed, your check must be dated 2024, and your envelope postmarked by December 31, 2024. Checks dated in 2024, but postmarked in 2025 must be credited, for IRS purposes in 2025.
