
Imagine that each floating plank represents an unpledged monetary gift from a household.

 to SHELBY to confirm set up. Then, it is as easy as texting the amount to the number.
 You do not need a key word if giving to the annual fund.
- Giving Stock: Our stock account is with Charles Schwab & Co, Inc. When giving stock, please sign a letter of instruction for your broker as follows: Please accept this letter of instruction to transfer __shares of _____securities as a gift to Selwyn Avenue Presbyterian, account #6598-4201, DTC Clearing 0164, Code 40. When calling your broker, also contact church accountant <u>Tonya Moore</u>, or 704-996-5504, so she is aware of the transaction and can credit the proper amount to the correct member.
- End-of-Year Giving reminder: The IRS requires the church receive checks/stocks in 2023 to be counted as a 2023 contribution. If delivered in person, the check must be received in the office by 1pm, December 29, 2023 or in 10:30am worship on December 31. If mailed, your check must be dated 2023, and your envelope postmarked by December 31, 2023. Checks dated in 2023, but postmarked in 2024 must be credited, for IRS purposes in 2024.
