CHARTING THE COURSE IN A CONFLICTED WORLE

SEPTEMBER 8 - OCTOBER 27

There's a place for everyone. Join us on September 8 at 9:30am as we start our new programming year. Adults can choose from two class series.

- Faith Forward Class (Intergenerational Class, Chapel) Do you ever feel powerless? The people of the early church discovered what true power looks like. Jesus transformed their lives—and they changed the world. Acts is the extraordinary record of what these early Christian disciples did. In the book *Acts 1-12: Traditional Bible Study Curriculum on the book of Acts, as* Phyllis J. Le Peau leads us through the Acts, you will begin to understand what the Holy Spirit can do in you and in the world. The power that you see in action in this book is the same power that can transform your life.
- Conversations on Faith Class (Parlor) Light. Bread. Shepherd. Life. The Gospel of John uses these and other symbols to paint a
 picture of who Jesus is. Through the I Am statements Jesus describes himself with rich images, showing us he is both fully human
 and fully divine and calling us as his followers. In Jesus Revealed: The I Am Statements in the Gospel of John, author Matt Rawle
 explores the "I Am" statements in John as works of art that resonate throughout the Gospel and all of Scripture. He shows how these
 words point beyond themselves to the deep mystery of Jesus Christ. Join this journey and experience the profound truth at the heart
 of the "I Am" statements: that Jesus is light and life, and he calls us to himself and offers us the hope of resurrection.
- Confirmation class will be offered for 7th and 8th graders starting September 8.
- Milestone, Worship Readiness 1.0 (five-year-olds to second grade, Bowman building) A five week class for non-readers and early
 readers listen to Bible stories, tour the sanctuary, and answer big questions about worship. Why and how do we worship? What is
 baptism and communion? This class is designed to help children participate and enjoy worship. This milestone will be celebrated
 on October 6 as children and their parents celebrate the Lord's Supper in worship.
- Sunday School (four-year-olds to fifth grade, Bowman building) At Selwyn, a child's faith formation is marked by appropriate
 milestones along the way. Children not participating in a specific milestone class are invited to discover a new story through stations
 that include a book corner, prayer table, story time, crafts and building. Children are invited to engage in stories about God's love
 through intentional, planned lessons and Montessori style learning.
- Nursery Care (for infants to three-years old) At this stage, your children need love and care, and you need to know they are safe and happy. While children are always welcomed in worship, experienced nursery caregivers welcome our youngest members between 9:15am and 11:45am each Sunday in two rooms - Crib/Toddlers and Three/Fours.




