As I look back, I'm overwhelmed with gratitude for what God has done in and through SCG Church in 2025. If I were to summarize last year in one word, it would be "realized." This is because in just this one year, we were able to realize so many of the things we have been praying for and working toward. It was a year marked by growth—not just in numbers but in stories of transformation, faith, and generosity. Every number in this report represents a real person, a real family, and a real encounter with God. This Impact Report is our way of celebrating those stories and saying thank you to everyone who made them possible.

At the center of everything we do is a simple truth: **Jesus Changes Everything**. In 2025, we saw that truth lived out as hundreds of people placed their trust in Jesus for the first time. Several years ago, we began celebrating baptisms during our weekend services, and it's become one of the most meaningful moments in our church life—new believers publicly sharing how Jesus has transformed them in front of the whole congregation. This year, we nearly doubled the number of baptisms compared to 2024.

We also saw what it looks like to **Live Differently** by doing life together. This fall, we opened the Community Life Center and launched our Jesus Changes Everything discipleship curriculum—immediately putting this new space to work. Thousands of people connected, grew, and found real community. In classes and discipleship groups, SCG'ers shared burdens, deepened their faith, and formed lasting friendships. We were reminded again that following Jesus was never meant to be done alone—it happens best in community.

Finally, I'm deeply thankful for the way our church chose to **Send It**—to serve, sacrifice, and share our faith. Through local outreach, global missions, campus events, and countless volunteer hours, SCG stepped beyond our walls to love our neighbors and our world. None of this would be possible without your faithful generosity and your willingness to say "yes" to what God is doing.

As you read through this report, my prayer is that you're encouraged by what God has done—and inspired by what He's still inviting us into, together!



VOLUNTEERS

We want people—and their kids—to absolutely love coming to church. From the moment they step on campus, whether they're here for the first time or they've been coming for years, we want them to feel like they've come home. Our dedicated volunteers make that possible. From shuttle to seat, they help every person feel seen, loved, and welcomed.

SCG KIDS

Our goal is to make church so fun that kids drag their parents here—and then beg them to stick around so they can hang with their friends. We want our youngest weekend attenders to meet Jesus and take their first steps of faith in an environment that's welcoming, safe, and full of God's love and truth. And we surround them with an incredible team of staff and dedicated volunteers who help kids know the love of Jesus from the bassinets in the nursery to the basketball court in the $\frac{1}{2}$ Theater.

CHAMPIONS CLUB

We believe people with special needs hold a special place in God's heart—and they hold a special place in ours, too. That's why we launched Champions Club ten years ago, and why it continues to thrive today. Each week, we help make SCG feel like home for children and adults with special needs. We meet every individual right where they are, in a space designed just for them—no matter their ability.

And it's a gift to share Jesus with them while also caring for their developmental, social-emotional, mental, and physical needs.

SCG PRESCHOOL

Some people love SCG so much that they come here every day. We call them preschoolers. We opened our preschool a year and a half ago with a clear vision: to provide high-quality early childhood education that nurtures kids spiritually, academically, and socially—with Jesus at the center of it all. We teach the foundational skills they'll need for kindergarten while helping them learn, in age-appropriate ways, about God's love and the Bible.

We love these kids, and it's a gift to help nurture them as they grow.

DISCIPLESHIP



In 2025, our pastors decided they were ready for a new challenge—so they wrote Jesus Changes Everything (JCE), a 10-week discipleship program built for SCG. Nearly 1,000 people in 80+ groups met weekly, packing out the new CLC. And the companion podcast? Turns out it was a hit—apparently you do like hearing from your pastors... who knew? The result: real spiritual growth, real friendships, and for many, the most impactful discipleship experience they've ever had.

944 participants completed the 10-week course

More than 80 discipleship groups formed

130 group leaders helped guide discussions

Avg. 700 listeners per daily podcast

Over 70 discipleship groups served in outreach

CLASSES, CARE, & LIFE-STAGE MINISTRIES

In 2025, we put “doing life together” to the test—and it turns out it’s actually better than doing life alone. Through groups and classes like Run With God, Moms Together, Seriously Dating & Engaged, Men’s and Women’s Ministry, Financial Peace University, and more, people built real friendships and strengthened their bodies, relationships, and faith in practical ways that stick (because “just try harder” has never been a great strategy). And when life got heavy, our Prayer & Care team was there too—offering after-service prayer, pastoral care and counseling, hospital visits, meals, and support through grief and major life transitions—so no one had to walk through the hard stuff alone.

LOCAL OUTREACH

In 2025, SCG leaned into serving, sacrificing, and sharing as a joyful way of life—living out what it means to love God and love others. Through financial gifts and volunteer hours, we supported a variety of local and international partners.

This is how we love our neighbors—by showing up with open hands and open hearts for families who could use a little extra support. Through long-standing ministries and new partnerships, SCG stepped in with safe places, steady care, and plenty of joy along the way. Whether it was hosting children through Safe Families, praying and bringing meals through Care Communities, or creating unforgettable moments at Royal Family Kids Camp, we kept it simple: love people like Jesus does—practically, faithfully, and together.

69 RFKC volunteers loved 30 foster care children through faith, fun, and connection

Safe Families Ministry: 12 families served, 18 children hosted, and 131 safe nights provided

Care Communities (with Olive Crest): 6 families supported by 36 volunteers through prayer, meals, and ongoing care

\$29,696 raised to support families affected by the January 2025 L.A. wildfires

900 gifts distributed to Boys and Girls Club, Olive Crest, and our ministry partners in Mexico

GLOBAL OUTREACH

SCG Church recognizes that sometimes loving our neighbors means getting on a plane, bouncing down crazy roads, eating food you can't quite pronounce, and crawling into bed completely exhausted (but strangely filled with peace). This is one of the ways we Send It—serving, sacrificing, and sharing the hope of Jesus with our global partners in places like El Salvador and Uganda. From building practical help in remote villages to strengthening pastors and rebuilding spaces for kids to learn and worship, we get to show up as the hands and feet of Jesus—and watch God do what only He can do.



El Salvador (Las Tablas): 11 men traveled to a remote mountain village and built 25 eco stoves, serving 125 residents

Uganda: A team of SCG pastors traveled 9,000+ miles to teach at a conference for hundreds of Ugandan pastors

Uganda Construction: \$210,000 raised to build a new youth building and church, and help rebuild a school for our ministry partners

Missionary Support: \$24,000 given to support missionaries around the world
