

Homecoming 2024 Student and Guest Permission Form

In order to attend the Red Lion Homecoming Dance, all students and guests must agree to comply with the following guidelines and submit the completed Permission Form to the Upper School Office. Once approved, the students' and guests' names will be added to the dance roster.

- All school rules are in effect.
- Only one guest per student (and must be of the opposite gender). •
- The Homecoming Dance will begin at 6:00 p.m. and finish by 9:30 p.m. All dance attendees and guests • must arrive before 6:30 p.m., at which time the doors will close.
- All non-Red Lion Christian Academy students must present some type of picture identification (school ID • or driver's license) in order to enter the dance.
- Guests must be in 9th to 12th grade student. Exceptions may be made by the administration. ٠
- Guests who do not attend a Red Lion or GCA must fill out and return a Permission Form at least 1 week prior to the event and have it approved before the RLCA student may purchase a ticket for him or her.
- Any guests or Red Lion Christian Academy students that choose to leave the dance will not be allowed to • return.
- Any guests in possession of alcohol or drugs or found under the influence of such substances will be denied • entrance to the dance, referred to the proper authorities, and reported to the guest's school.
- Any guests who do not comply with the directives of the administration or chaperones will be removed from • the dance.
- All female guests must adhere to the following Red Lion Christian Academy dress guidelines: • Dress Code:
 - Please see Homecoming Dress Code Policy Form.

- All dresses/skirts must be approved by the RLCA administration prior to the event and the determination of modesty lies solely at their discretion. A photo will be taken of the student in the dress and kept in a binder so dresses can be checked at the dance, if needed. In the event that there is a change to the previously approved dress or the actual dress is not worn as approved, the student will not be allowed to enter the event and will forfeit the ticket price.

- All male guests must adhere to the following RLCA dress guideline: •
 - -Males are not required to wear a jacket.
 - -A collared shirt is the minimum requirement for gentlemen attending Homecoming.

-Males may wear khakis or dress pants. No jeans are allowed.

Students must meet the above standards before they can enter the dance.
