

In seeking to steward the gospel, should Stockham Community Church proceed with the vision to build the presented plans with an estimated quote of \$5,050,000 by collecting funds to further discern if building is a feasible option?

- Expectations of a “Yes” vote:
 - Those voting “Yes” are not only voting on a ballot, but are voting with their prayers, finances and actions in support of the project.
 - If the vote receives 80% or more “Yes” votes, then we will proceed forward with the project.
 - A fundraising committee will be appointed and will begin a campaign to collect pledges.
 - Once 80% of the funds are pledged, those funds will begin to be collected. Once we have 50% of the funds in cash, the project will break ground.
 - The Deacons will search for and appoint a small committee to lead the project on a day to day basis.
 - All funds will be used for building project purposes.

- Expectations of a “No” vote:
 - Those voting “No” are voting against the presented plans with a desire to pursue an alternative option.
 - Other options include: pursuing remodel projects, two Sunday services, planting a church or doing nothing.
 - If the vote does not receive 80% or more “Yes” votes, then church leadership will take some time to discern and present a different option to the church.
