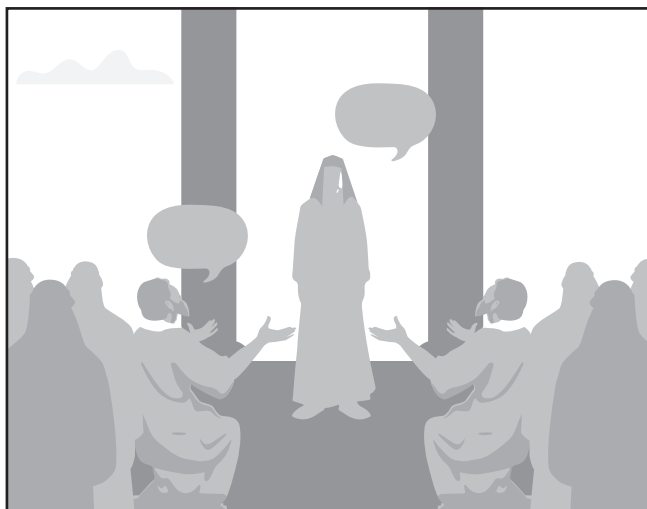

Find the differences in the picture of Joseph and his brothers.

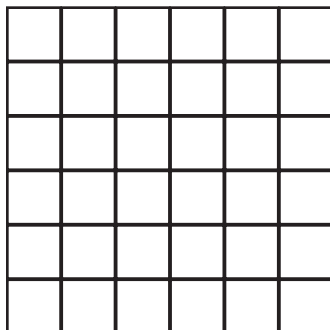

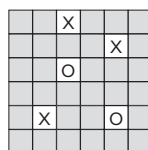
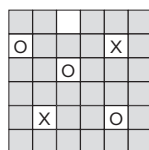
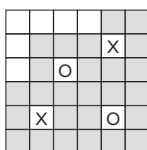
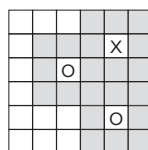
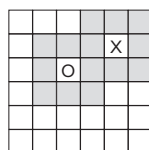
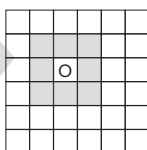
CAMPFIRE
