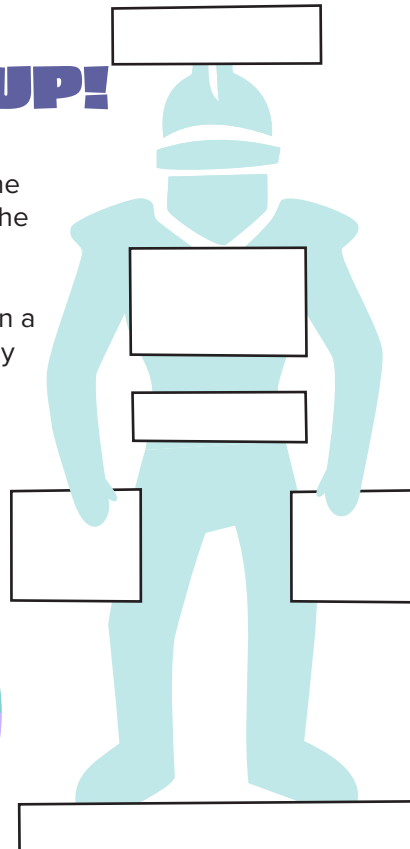
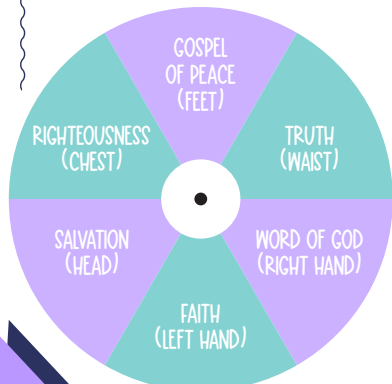
## ON YOUR OWN FIND THE DIFFERENCE

Find and circle five differences between the pictures from today's Bible story. Remember that God is always with you. You can pray and know that God will help you stand strong and be secure in Him.

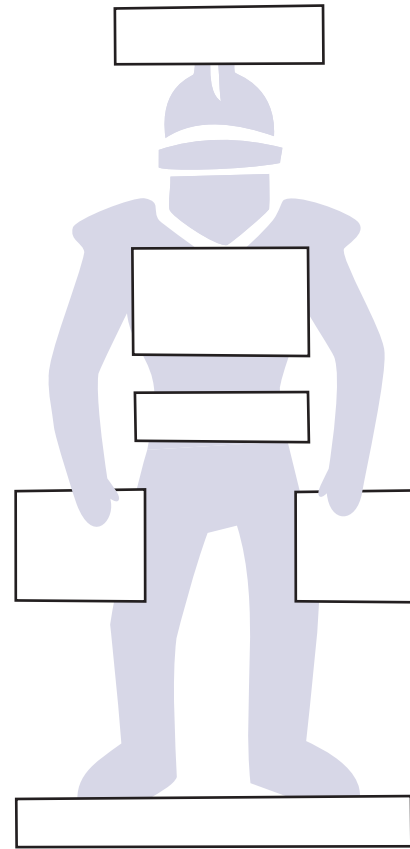


## FUN WITH A FRIEND ARMOR UP!
