John 1:35-51 (ESV)

- 1. The Messengers: God Uses Ordinary People
 - John the Baptist
 - Andrew
 - Phillip
 - Who are you bringing to Jesus?

2. The Method: The Power of an Invitation

- Are we connecting with people far from Jesus?
- The power of the invitation "Come and See"
- Are we personally inviting people into an authentic **community**?

3. The Message: Who Jesus Really Is

- Lamb of God The sacrifice for our sins. (v. 36)
- Rabbi / Teacher The one who leads us in truth. (v. 38)
- Fulfillment of Prophecy The long-awaited Messiah. (v. 45)
- Son of God & King of Israel The true King. (v. 49)
- Son of Man The bridge between Heaven and Earth. (v. 51)



Conclusion: The Challenge

- Jesus' movement started with simple invitations: "Come and see."
- Who is God calling you to invite? Not just to a church service—but into your life, your small group, your faith journey.

Challenge: This week, invite someone—to a small group, a Bible study, or even just a conversation about faith. **You never know whose life will change because of your invitation.**
