John 9:1-41 (ESV)
1. The Source of our Suffering (John 9:1-5) And his disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"
A Biblical Framework: S.U.F.F.E.R.I.N.G.
S - <u>Sin</u> of Adam (fallen world) U - Unclean <u>Spirits</u> (demonic opposition) F - <u>Folly</u> (consequences of foolishness) F - <u>Forewarning</u> E - <u>Empathy</u> (suffering with others) R - <u>Rebuke</u> (Godly discipline) I - <u>Injury</u> from Others (abuse and oppression) N - Name of <u>Jesus</u> (persecution) G - God's <u>Hidden</u> Will
2. The Power of Obedience (John 9:6-12) 11 He answered, "The man called Jesus made mud and anointed my eyes and said to me, 'Go to Siloam and wash.' So I went and washed and received my sight."
3. The Blindness of <u>Religion</u> (John 9:13-34)
