The Savior (Luke 2:27-28) 27 So he (Simeon) came by the <u>Spirit</u> into the temple. And when the parents brought in the <u>Child Jesus</u> , to do for Him according to the <u>custom of the law</u> , 28 he took Him up in his arms and <u>blessed God</u>
Simeon's Song: "My Eyes Have Seen Salvation" Nunc Dimittis: Latin "Now let depart" <u>God's promise fulfilled; hope realized.</u>
1. Seeing God's <u>salvation</u> plan.
2. Understanding the full consequences: Destined to cause the <u>rising and falling of many</u> .

Inclusive Exclusivity (John 14:6-7)

6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. 7 If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."

Respond: How can I be like "Simeon" to listen for, hear from, and wair patiently for God as He reveals His plan through me to proclaim His hope and salvation to those in my life?
