The Book of Ecclesiastes

Ecclesiastes #8 | Walking, Standing, Sitting Ecclesiastes 4:9-16, Psalm 1 (ESV)

9 "Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. 10 For if they fall, one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up!"

Big Idea: To avoid the "slow drift" into isolation and vanity, we must intentionally plant our lives in the soil of God's Word and anchor ourselves in a godly community that keeps us rooted in Jesus

ACTION:

How to live this out

1. Choose to make Jesus the main Focus.

2. Choose your circle wisely.

3. Make a plan.
