- Is experiential and **subjective** (2 Peter 3:18; 2 Cor. 7:11).
- Is accomplished by the **Word** of God (John 17:17; 15:3; Eph. 5:26).
- Relates to separation **from** a sinful walk **to** divine character (2 Cor. 3:18).
- Sets us apart to a holy _____ (2 Peter 3:18; 1 Thess. 4:3-4; 2 Pet. 7:1).

Future Sanctification:

- Is ultimate and **complete** (1 Thess. 3:12-13; 5:23; Eph. 5:27; Rom. 6:11).
- Is accomplished by the **presence** of Christ (1 John 3:2b).
- Relates to separation **from** a sinful nature **to** divine perfection (1 John 3:2).
- Sets us apart to a holy _____ (1 John 3:2).
