1. <b>His Call:</b> "Before I formed you, I knew you, and before you were born consecrated you. I appointed you Prophet to the Nations." <b>1:5</b>

5. <b>The Greatest Compliment:</b> "Let not the wise man boast in his, let not the strong man boast in his, or the wealthy man boast in his But let those who boast, boast in this, that they and ME, that I am the LORD. I act with steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the Earth, for in these things I, says the LORD" <b>9:23-24</b>

10. Jeremiah counseled the next king, Zedekiah, to the commanders of the Babylonian army that was ransacking his country. <b>38:17.</b> He promised the young king that if he obeyed the Voice of the LORD, it would with him. Instead Zedekiah stated that he of the angry Judeans who had deserted to the Chaldeans. <b>38:19</b> (he didn't listen)
11. After of siege, the Babylonians finally broke through the walls of Jerusalem. Zedekiah, but was quickly caught. <b>Ch. 39</b>
12. The Survivors <b>Ruined their Chance</b> to: After the majority of the Babylonian Army left the devastated country of Judah, survivors who had fled from the war started returning. Jeremiah told them, "Do not to serve the Chaldeans and it will go well with you" <b>40:9</b> Instead a military leader,, assassinated the Babylonian-appointed governor Gedaliah. Great chaos ensued. <b>Ch. 41-42</b>
13. The remaining Jewish military leaders <b>consulted Jeremiah</b> , they would obey the LORD, if the LORD told them what to do. They were told specifically In the Fear of Man, they deliberately disobeyed GOD and went to Egypt. <b>Ch. 43-44</b>
14. <b>These Complicit Nations</b> were judged also for their crimes: (46), Philistia (47), (48), Ammon,, Syria (49) and finally (50-51)
15. <b>King Zedekiah's foolish legacy</b> . This last king of Judah's lack of the Fear of the LORD cost him his, his, his freedom, his, and his country. The survivors of the war () were led captive to Babylon. (52)
