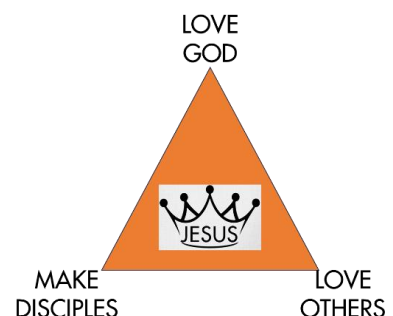


 - i. Affirm their identity in Christ and the authority he gives
 - ii. Encourage their unique gifts and remind them of who they are
 - iii. Provide tools: scriptures, prayers, ministry opportunities
 - d. Released:
 - i. Give them space to lead and teach others
 - ii. Debrief with them – ask what God showed them
 - iii. Celebrate growth – Cheer for them
 - iv. Trust the Holy Spirit in them, even if they do things differently from you
