

MEN'S SPRING ROAD TRIP

Gettysburg, Pennsylvania

May 6 - 9, 2024



The Battle of Gettysburg was a turning point in the Civil War. The Union victory ended General Robert E. Lee's second and most ambitious invasion of the North. Often referred to as the "High Water Mark of the Rebellion," Gettysburg was the Civil War's bloodiest battle and was also the inspiration for President Abraham Lincoln's immortal "Gettysburg Address."

ITINERARY:

Day #1: Leave COS at 7:00 AM travel to Gettysburg, PA. Trip is about 520 miles and should take around 10 hours.

Day #2: Tour the Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center, including the Cyclorama. Travel to Sight and Sound Theater in Lancaster for a showing of *Daniel*.

Day #3: Tour Gettysburg Battlefield on a chartered bus with a licensed guide.

Day #4: Return home.
