WELCOME

It is the tradition of Church of the Savior to dedicate forty days to pray for our world, our nation, our community and our families. The forty days follow the period of Lent, beginning with Ash Wednesday and ending the day before Resurrection Sunday. We exclude Sundays because those days are set aside for corporate worship at COS and/or your home.

Each week of prayer centers around a theme set by Pastor Steve and the Prayer Design Team. There is one page for each of the forty days. You will find daily scriptures followed by a prayer written by a member of our church family. The bottom of each page includes four prayer prompts:

-  topic for our COS family
-  a local church and pastor
-  one of our COS Global Partners
-  local government officials

We suggest you set aside a specific time each day to pray. Start with reading a few (or many) verses of Scripture. Then quiet your mind and listen to see if the Holy Spirit has a thought for you. Then pray.

It is also beneficial to pray with others: your spouse, your family or a friend. The introduction page for each week lists opportunities to join others for prayer here at COS. For a complete list of prayer groups, please visit our website: churchofthesavior.net/prayer.

We trust that you will be blessed by this guide and know that your prayers will have a great effect in the spiritual atmosphere of our community, our state, and our nation.
