Then we will visit the infamous **Andersonville National Historic Site**, the former Confederate prisoner-of-war camp where over 13, 000 men died and were buried. That afternoon we will return to Columbus to visit the **National Civil War Naval Museum** which houses numerous naval artifacts including a complete confederate warship.

Day #1 (Monday): Leave COS at 7:00 AM travel to Columbus, GA. Trip is about 486 miles and should take around 9 hours.

Day #2 (Tuesday): Tour the National Infantry Museum and Soldier Center in Columbus.

Day #3 (Wednesday): Tour the Andersonville National Historic Site. Return to Columbus and visit the National Civil War Naval Museum.

Day #4 (Thursday): Return home.
