## Family Bible Challenge Week 6

**Scripture:** Genesis Chapter 3

**Background:** Now that our first month of the FBC is complete we will shift our focus from Easter to learning about important characters in the Old Testament. This week we are starting with our parents Adam and Eve. These are two of the most important people in the Bible, because their actions set the stage for the rest of human history. Adam and Eve were regular people like you and I. Adam was God's representative for humanity. He had a fight with temptation and lost, the consequences were catastrophic. There is hope even in the midst of loss and the rest of the Bible is the story of God restoring everything that was lost through the actions of Adam.

## Questions for discussion:

- 4. If you didn't know the consequences of sin would you have been able to say o to the temptation Adam faced?
- 5. It is important to know that all of our actions affect the next generation. What are some good things and bad things you have in common with your children?

**Prayer:** Thank God that even when we sin he covers us! Pray that generational curses will be broken in your family, and for unity.
