| #1-God is always at work around you. | God was already at work around Moses. (See Exodus 2:23-25) | |
| #2-God pursues a continuing love relationship with you that is real and personal. | God pursued a continuing love relationship with Moses that was real and personal. (See Exodus 24:12, 15-16, 18) | |
| #3-God invites you to become involved with Him and His work. | God invited Moses to become involved with him and his work. (See Exodus 3:8, 10) | |
| #4-God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes, and His ways. | God spoke to reveal himself, his purposes, and his ways. (See Exodus 3:2-8 and Numbers 12:6-8) | |
| #5-God's invitation for you to work with Him, always leads you to a crisis of belief that requires faith and action. | God's invitation for Moses to work with Him led to a crisis of belief that required faith and action. (See Exodus 3:11, 13; 4:1, 10, 13) | |
| #6-You must make major adjustments in your life to join God and what he is doing. | Moses had to make a major adjustment in his life to join God and what he was doing. (See Exodus 4:19-20) | |
| #7-You come to know God by experience as you obey Him, and He accomplishes His work through you. | Moses came to know God by experience as he obeyed God and God accomplished His work through Moses. (See Exodus 14:15-17, 21-23, 26-27, 29-31) | |
