- While there was a significant increase in negative Operating Cash, it is forecasted that we will end the year favorable to budget.



Christ Brings Freedom: Paul's Letter to the Galatians

New Bible Study Begins January 21 at 9:05 or 10:15 am in the North Building Multi-Use Room. As a world traveler, Paul had seen many slaves — people whose lives were completely controlled by powerful governments, leaders, and landowners. Yet Paul himself had been a slave... to religious zealotry and to the endless demands of keeping religious laws.

Paul now knew what it meant to be free and to know true liberty in Christ. Having experienced both slavery and freedom, nothing bothered Paul more than seeing people return to bondage. But that's exactly what he had heard about his friends in the church he founded in Galatia. These new Christians, who had found freedom in Christ, were being pressured to return to the slavery of religious rules and regulations. Paul's response was quick and strong—don't desert Christ, don't be foolish, don't be a prisoner or a slave to sin; instead, follow Christ and **BE FREE!**

In *The Letter to the Galatians*, Paul proclaims the reality of liberty in Christ—freedom from the law and the power of sin, and freedom to serve the living Lord. Are you trapped in sin? You can be a child of God through faith in Christ Jesus, an heir to the promise, and truly free indeed. Are you trapped in religious legalism, trying to earn favor with God by doing good and being good? Don't be burdened by such slavery, because you can stand firm and free in Christ.

This new six-week class will dive into *Paul's Letter to the Galatians* to discover how and in what ways Jesus has brought us freedom. Led by Barry Ritchie, this study will discuss the many facets of freedom in Christ that this letter holds for us. The book we'll use is from the Life Application Bible Study series; copies will be available for purchase (\$8.00). 
