
# SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

Weird Stuff Christians Do - Week 3



## CONNECT

Spend some time checking in. What are highs and lows since you last met? How can your group members pray for and support each other this week?

## **GROW**

What ordinary rituals are important to you? How long have they been rituals in your life, and what makes them important?

What memories do you have around baptism, whether it was your own or someone else's? What about the celebration of communion?

For you, what's different about having *tangible reminders* of things rather than just *intellectual reminders* of things? Do you remember differently when there's a tangible or physical reminder? Why or why not?

Why is it important to make faith tangible? What else makes faith familiar to you, aside from baptism and communion? Why is it important to have both the familiar and things that stretch us in our faith?

When you struggle, what helps remind you that nothing will get in the way of God's love for you?

### **BIBLE**

Read Matthew 3:13, Matthew 28:19, and 1 Corinthians 11:23-25. What do you notice?

### **PRAY**

Gracious God, You created us for each other. Guide us to use our speech and our actions to draw other people closer to you. Amen.
