



# LETTER FROM PASTOR TROY

#### Dear Grace Church Family,

I am grateful and in awe of what God is doing in and through Grace Church. As we stand firm in the Word and focus on biblical truth, He is working in and through this church.

Because of God's faithfulness, we have experienced incredible growth and seen unprecedented engagement throughout the past ministry year. Thank you for being committed to prayer, God's Word, and our church.

Below is a snapshot of God's grace, evidenced by record-high attendance and noteworthy levels of impact, reach, and spiritual maturity.

#### **Growth**

Weekly attendance is up 48% year-over-year, with Chaska attendance up 13% and online attendance up 80%. Research indicates that regular online attendance often leads to live

attendance, so the increase may indicate even more people coming to church in the future!

### **Biblical Teaching, Spiritual Depth**

Our ministries continue to do incredible work and encourage spiritual depth through Bible studies, classes, and community groups. Last fall, a record number of people signed **up for studies and groups!** We've also seen lives impacted through special events.

#### **Across the Street, Around the World**

We exist to glorify God by making disciples of Jesus Christ across the street and around the world, and we're seeing people **ENGAGE** in this mission **and care for people near and far.** 

#### The Next Generation, 0 to 18

We remain focused on discipling and engaging the next generation for Christ and are currently undergoing major renovations to accommodate our growing Grace Beginnings, Grace Kids, and NXT Students ministries.

#### What's Next?

As more people come to Grace and, more importantly, come to faith in Christ, we continue to expand our offerings to better care for and advance the Kingdom.

As we move into the new ministry year, we're preparing to launch a new ministry – Re:Generation, a Christ-centered care and discipleship program.

We are also renovating our Eden Prairie location as part of our Grace Beginnings school upgrade and adding several new or improved spaces for many of our ministries. (Wait until you see what's coming this fall!)

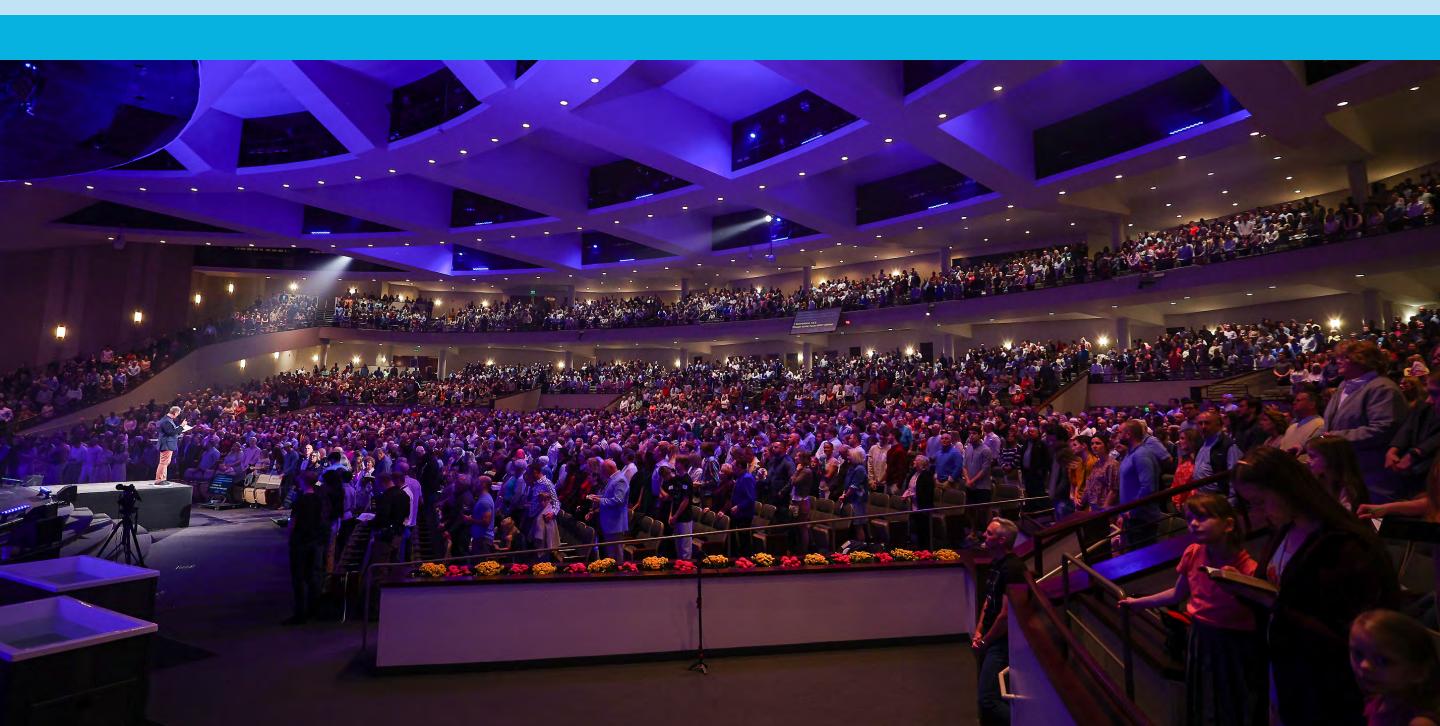
Plus, we are expanding our physical footprint with a new site in Pocatello, Idaho.
