HOSPITALITY TEAM

Our Sunday LifeGroup leaders serve on a weekly basis in a minimum of 3 person teams. They rotate teaching Bible study lessons, care for students in the group through prayer and follow up, and look to build meaningful relationships. Our groups are divided by grade and gender at both hours. The 9:15 am hour will be the primary time for high school, 11:00 am will primarily be for middle school; however, we will have a place for any age student at both hours. We provide curriculum and will coach you in effectively caring for your group of students.



Wednesday Night Leaders | Wednesdays, 6-8 pm | 25 Adults Our Wed. night service for 7th-12th graders is called The HOUSE. The HOUSE is a "front door" to our student ministry. We worship, play games, hear messages from Scripture, and aim to build meaningful community. We need leaders to build relationships with students, model behavior and serve as an example for how to worship King Jesus in a group setting, and serve as small group discussion leaders. Typical nights include hang out time from 6 pm-6:30 pm; service from 6:30 pm-7:30 pm, and small groups from 7:30 pm to 8:00 pm. Every other week we also have post-service activities like House Parties and WAC (Wednesday After Church) where we need adult help from 8-9:00 pm.

Multiply Group Leaders | 12 Male, 12 Female

Our Multiply groups are the most committed and concentrated outlet for students to grow and practice serving as disciple makers. Groups run for the entire school year and meet weekly in the evenings, typically Sunday nights. We need adult leaders who are passionate about small group discipleship and are willing to lead groups of 4-6 students while also sharing leadership with older high school students who are ready to lead Multiply Groups. Commit 1.5-2 hours to your groups each week that you meet.

Special Event Team | 40 Women

Works under the direction of leadership to execute all aspects of Women's Ministry special events, including retreats, conferences and fellowship opportunities. Service times vary depending on the Women's Ministry calendar of events. *Note: not a primary area of service.*

SENIOR ADULT MINISTRY

Senior Adult Hospitality Team | 12 Adults

This group of people is responsible for facilitating the pot-luck dishes and beverages for Best Yet Night, the monthly senior adult meal. *Note:* not a primary area of service.

Bus Driver for Day Trips | 2 Adults

These individuals would be available to drive the church bus on our monthly Senior Adult day trips. Commercial Driver's License is required.

Bereavement Meal Team | 8 Adults

This group of people would be available to assist with a family meal for funerals of our church members when needed. *Note: not a primary area of service.*

Senior Adult Visitation Team | 10 People

This team would make visits to people who are homebound or are in rehab/care facilities. Goal is to have five teams of two people.

Adopt a School at Griffin Elementary and Smith Intermediate | 40 Adults


Individuals who will encourage all staff by writing letters, delivering food, book fair and additional opportunities throughout the school year. Days and times will vary.
