
GOD

WHAT IS
SIN?

At the very center of that target

The "bull's-eye" marks perfection,

Any shot you take that doesn't
hit the "bull's-eye" is called sin or
"missing the mark."

God is holy. This means He always hits
the mark - He is perfect.

PROBLEM

And this is our big problem:

If God is perfect and sin cannot live with Him, and we sin...

RESPONSE


Now, if you choose to turn to Jesus,

Romans 10:9-10, John 1:12



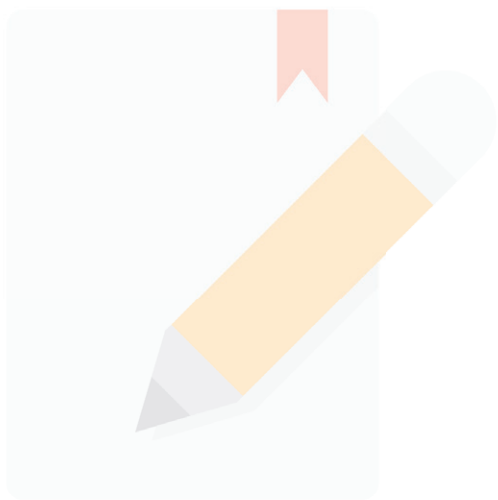
If you just asked Jesus to be your King, we want to celebrate with you! At FBC Forney, we have a book that is just for you called "King of Me."
