



God is Holy,
that means
He's perfect.
In fact,
He's so perfect,
sin cannot
live with Him.

Isaiah 6:3, 1 John 1:5, 1 Peter 1:15-16, Matthew 5:48



Sin is "missing the mark."

Think about shooting a bow and arrow at a target.

At the very center of that target is a "bull's-eye."

The "bull's-eye" marks perfection, but it is very difficult to hit.

Any shot you take that doesn't hit the "bull's-eye" is called sin or "missing the mark."

God is holy. This means He always hits the mark - He is perfect.

Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:8-9



On the other hand, we have missed the mark.

For example, we disobey our parents, we are not kind to others, and we lie.

We have turned away from God and we sin.

Mark 7:21, Ecclesiastes 7:20, Jeremiah 17:9



And this is our big problem:

If God is perfect and sin cannot live with Him, and we sin...

WE cannot live with God.

We have turned away from God

and our sin has separated us

from God, both now

AND when we die, which means we must spend forever in a lake of fire called Hell.

Romans 6:23, Isaiah 59:2 Micah 3:4, Revelation 20:11-15



But that is not what God wants.

God loves you so much that He gave away His only Son to save you from your sin and Hell.

Jesus Christ died on the cross in your place to forgive you of your sin and He rose again three days later.

John 3:16-17, Romans 6:23 1 Corinthians 15:3-6, 1 John 2:1-2



Now, if you choose to turn to Jesus, He will forgive your sin and hit the bull's-eye for you. All you need to do is:

- 1. Admit to Jesus that you have missed the mark.
- 2. Believe Jesus is God's Son and that He died on the cross to save you.
- 3. Confess with your mouth that Jesus is the boss or King of your life.

If you believe in your heart that these things are true and you are ready to ask Jesus to be your King, He is ready to save you.

Are you ready?

Romans 10:9-10, John 1:12
