#### Peace and Harmony

Years ago, I saw an interview featuring Ed Brandon, a long tenured weatherman with Channel 13. He told of a time that a doctor, with stethoscope against his chest, saying, "Ed, you're having a heart attack *right now!*" He did not know he was having a problem. His body was struggling for peace and harmony and what Ed didn't know almost killed him!

On November 17, 2009, I was intubated while the doctors ran all the tests they could for meningitis, bird flu, swine flu, and a host of other possibilities to ascertain what was going on in my body. I had contracted Pneumococcal Pneumonia. What was the cause? Extra bacteria and contamination in my blood. After an auto accident, in 1973, I had a ruptured spleen and the doctors took it out. Without the spleen, as the 2<sup>nd</sup> filter of the blood, it allowed impurities into my blood and finally the body said, "I'm done!" I did not know that I needed a Pneumococcal Vaccine. My body was searching for peace and harmony. What I did not know...almost killed me!

As the pneumonia was traveling through by body trying to destroy everything in its path, it made it to my inner ear and destroyed it. I praise the Lord daily that the doctors caught it before it hit the auditory nerve. With the auditory nerve still functioning, I was a candidate for Cochlear Implants.

The church, just as the physical body works to have peace and harmony. In Paul's letter to the Corinthians, he writes, "For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ" (1 Corinthians 12:12, ESV). He goes on to liken the church to a physical body, with each member serving a distinct purpose, yet all working together for the common good. The church seeks peace and harmony. Are you seeking peace and harmony? What you don't know, can kill vou!
